Show Rules & Information

ENTRIES: Please submit entries via TRHP.horsespot.net. Entry Closing Date: October 10th, 2025 by 6pm.

LATE FEES: Entries submitted after the deadline will be charged a \$25 late fee.

CLASS FEES: \$25 per class. Hunter Derby: \$50.

STALL FEES: \$115 each, from Friday-Sunday. Shavings: \$12/Bag (3 Minimum). No outside shavings allowed. Early Move-In or Late Move-Out available for \$35 per night, including tack stalls. Horse not renting a stall will be charged a grounds fee of \$45. SHOW FEES: Each horse/rider combination will be charged an EMT fee of \$20. An EMT will be on grounds during posted schooling and show times. A \$15 office/\$10 NTHJC scholarship fee will be charged at \$25 per horse-rider combination. Open check fee of \$15 will be charged for all accounts not closed at the show. A credit or debit card on file is required at the time of entry, but entry may be paid with check on the date of the show.

PRIZE MONEY: A W-9 form must be completed in full before any prize money will be paid. Prize money will be withheld if the recipients' Social Security number or EIN is not on file.

CONVENIENCE FEE: A convenience fee of 4% of the total invoice will be added to all invoices being paid with a credit or debit card.

REFUND POLICY: After the closing date, entries can be refunded less the \$25 office fee which is not refundable. Stall fees are not refundable after the closing date.

NON-SHOWING ENTRIES: Non-showing entries will be charged a \$40 schooling fee, in addition to show and stall or grounds fees. Non-showing entries are required to pay Office/Scholarship Fee and EMT Fee. All horses on the grounds must be registered in the show office and receive a back number.

USHJA OUTREACH PROGRAM: The show will be recognized by USHJA Outreach and qualify for USHJA Outreach points for Zone 7. To read more about the USHJA Outreach program and get your free membership, visit their website at: https://www.ushja.org/competition/outreach

NTHJC MEMBERSHIP: A current NTHJC membership is required for each rider. If needed, membership can be completed at http://www.nthjc.com.

NTHJC THOROUGHBRED HIGH POINT AWARDS: TB registered name or tattoo # is required. Entry must be completed on http://www.nthjc.com prior to the completion of the show. Thank you to **Oak View Equestrian** for sponsoring our High Point TB Awards.

COGGINS: Proof of a negative Coggins (EIA) within one year is required by state law. No entry will be accepted without a Copy of the Original Coggins test which may be emailed to amy@equine-events.net with entries or presented to the show office upon arrival. Includes non-showing entries.

ARENAS: RWB Ring: 180x300 Premier Equestrian Artificial mix footing. Park Tax Arena: 160' x 280' Sand Composite footing. Spring Hill Inn Ring 135' x 300'. Covered Arena 125x235. Both with sand composite footing. Footing quality is a priority and rings may be closed during inclement weather or for maintenance at any time during the show.

SCHOOLING: There will be open schooling in all rings Friday from 12:00PM until 6:00PM. Schooling available prior to ring start according to posted times on the schedule. No Jumper schooling on Saturday or Sunday.

LIMIT DIVISIONS: Limit divisions are open to riders who begin the show season without having won 5 blue ribbons over fences. After winning five (5) blue ribbons over fences the rider may continue to compete in this Division for the remainder of the show season. Warm up or Add Back blue ribbons will not count in the allowed Limit Blue Ribbons. Limit Riders may NOT show in any classes over 2'0 at this show.

Show Rules & Information (cont.)

CROSS ENTRIES: A horse/rider combination may cross enter only into divisions with fence heights of a 6" difference. Walk Trot Poles may only cross enter in Walk Trot Crossrails. Walk Trot Crossrails may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18". Riders in Short Stirrup 18" may only cross enter into Limit Beginner 18". Riders competing in 2' Open Hunter may not cross enter into 2' Jr/Am Hunter.

AWARDS: All classes receive a first place Prize and 6 ribbons unless otherwise noted. A Champion ribbon & Prize and a Reserve Champion ribbon will be awarded for each division.

ATTIRE: Formal show attire is required in all classes. Jumper riders are permitted to wear polo shirts.

HELMETS: Properly fastened protective headgear must be worn at all times by all riders when mounted anywhere on show grounds. All headgear must meet or exceed ASTM standards, carry SEI tag and be properly fitted and secured by a harness.

DOGS: All dogs must be on a leash held in hand or confined.

CONCESSIONS: Concessions will be available during show hours.

SPLIT CLASSES: All classes, except warm-ups and specialty classes, with 20 or more entries will be split. Classes 18" and under will be split at 16 entries.

WARNING: Under Texas law (Chapter 87, Civil, Practice & Remedies Code), an equine professional is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities.

TOP 10

- 1. PARKING: Parking in designated areas only. NO PARKING is allowed in the barn area. TEMPORARY PARKING in barn areas is for the unloading and loading of trailers only. All trailers should be dropped in the approved lot and are not allowed to park in the stabling area. Public Parking is in designated areas only.
- 2. CAMPER'S/RV'S/HORSE TRAILERS WITH LIVING SPACE: Must go to campground for hook-up. NO HOOK-UP ALLOWED TO THE BARNS AT ANY TIME! Limited spots available. Please reserve your space at www.texasrosehorsepark.com or through the TRHP Show Services Office. RV spaces are assigned through TRHP Show Services Office.
- 3. GOLF CARTS/ATV'S: a privilege-not a right-extended to show participants. Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicle, as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the Rental Agreement of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Golf carts can be rented through TRHP show services in the show office. Golf carts are rented on a first come first served basis and TRHP strongly suggests that reservations be made in advanced. NO FOUR-WHEELERS, THREE WHEELERS, OR MOTOR BIKES OVER 50 cc ARE ALLOWED ON PARK GROUNDS. Golf Carts, mopeds, rural rate vehicles such as Gators and Mules, scooters, small motor bikes, and bicycles are allowed.
- **4. DOGS:** Must be on a leash (not to exceed 6 feet in length) or suitably restrained in a tack stall/cage etc. Loose animal/s left in vehicles in distress, etc. can and will be removed from the grounds at the owner's expense.
- **5. HORSES:** Have the right-of-way at all times.
- **6. EXHIBITOR PROBLEMS/SPECIAL REQUESTS:** All non-emergency problems or special requests must be relayed through show management to ensure prompt attention.
- 7. FIRE CODES: TRHP does not allow any of the following in stalls, barns or tents:
 - No 2-prong plug appliances. No 2-prong plug extension cords. No light duty cords for indoor use.
 - No 3-way adaptors unless specifically made for outdoors.
 - No cooking in barns or tents.
 - No smoking in barns or tents.
 - No overloading electrical outlets.
 - No electrical cords on the ground or buried. FANS IN THE STABLE AREA THAT ARE CONNECTED TO A 3-PRONG HEAVY DUTY OUTDOOR EXTENSION CORD OR 3-PRONG OUTDOOR ADAPTER ARE ACCEPTABLE.
- 8. STALLS: TRHP does not permit the use of any nails, fencing staples, screws, duct tape, or any other things to be driven into any portion of the stalls or buildings, nor the signs to be affixed, with any type of material(s) that may cause damage, changes, alterations, repairs, painting or staining of any part of the stalls or buildings. Any erection or installation of equipment must be made with material(s) that are temporary in nature and will not cause permanent damage such as zipties, Velcro, light duty staples, masking tape, etc. A stall deposit will be charged for bringing in outside shavings, refundable if stall is clean upon leaving.
- 9. WASTE DISPOSAL: All trash should be placed in proper containers that are located throughout the park. Muck generated during event must be placed in designated areas. Muck should not be placed in the barns, at the end of the barns, or in any other non-designated area.
- **10. SCHOOLING/LUNGEING:** Schooling is at designated times/places only and will be set and posted by show management. Lungeing is not allowed in any arena. Lunge in designated areas only.
