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## Privacy Policies & HIPAA Compliance

Limelight Medical Aesthetics is committed to protecting the privacy and security of patient information.

- The Practice collects personal health information necessary to provide safe and effective care. This may include medical history, current health information, and other relevant details.
- Health information may be used for treatment, payment, and healthcare operations, as permitted by law.
- Personal health information is protected under the **Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA)**.
- Limelight Medical Aesthetics maintains reasonable physical, administrative, and technical safeguards to protect patient information.
- Only the minimum necessary information is used or disclosed for its intended purpose.
- The Practice may work with trusted third-party business associates who are legally required to protect patient information.
- Patients have the right to request access to, amendments of, or restrictions on their health information, or an accounting of disclosures, by submitting a written request to the Practice.

## Virtual Appointments

- Virtual appointments may be available for select consultations and follow-up appointments.
- Virtual appointments may be conducted by video or phone when appropriate.
- Limelight Medical Aesthetics uses secure platforms to protect patient privacy during virtual visits. I understand that electronic communication carries some inherent risk and agree to participate in virtual visits from a private and secure location.

## Treatment Risks & Informed Consent

- I understand that all aesthetic treatments and skincare recommendations carry potential risks, including irritation, sensitivity, or unexpected results.
- Results are not guaranteed and may vary between individuals. I understand that aesthetic treatments and skincare services carry inherent risks and that individual results may vary.
- I have had the opportunity to ask questions and understand the recommendations provided.
- Limelight Medical Aesthetics and its providers are not responsible for adverse outcomes except in cases of proven negligence or intentional misconduct.

## Photography & Media Use

- Photographs may be taken before, during, or after treatment to document care, track progress, or for educational purposes.
- Photographs will not be used for marketing or public-facing purposes without separate patient authorization.

## Privacy Practices & Patient Rights (HIPAA)

Limelight Medical Aesthetics is committed to protecting the privacy and security of personal health information in accordance with HIPAA.

## Use & Disclosure of Health Information

- Health information may be used or disclosed for treatment, payment, and healthcare operations, as permitted by law.
- Information may be shared with trusted healthcare partners or business associates who are required to protect patient privacy.
- Health information may also be disclosed when required by law or for approved public health purposes.

## Patient Rights

Patients have the right to access and request copies of their health information, request corrections or amendments to their records, and request restrictions or confidential communications when reasonably possible. Patients may also request an accounting of certain disclosures as permitted by law and may request a copy of the Practice's full [Notice of Privacy Practices](#) at any time.

## Privacy, Updates & Acknowledgment

Limelight Medical Aesthetics maintains reasonable physical, administrative, and technical safeguards to protect the privacy and security of personal health information in accordance with applicable federal and state laws. In the event of a breach involving unsecured protected health information, patients will be notified as required by law.

Patients may contact Limelight Medical Aesthetics with questions or concerns regarding privacy practices and have the right to file a complaint with the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, Office for Civil Rights. Limelight Medical Aesthetics will not retaliate against any patient for filing a complaint.

Limelight Medical Aesthetics reserves the right to update or modify its policies, procedures, and consent forms at any time. Updated policies will be made available upon request or during future visits.
