The pets of our neighbors need help too! The pantry is now accepting bagged dog and cat food, any brand, along with our other donated items.

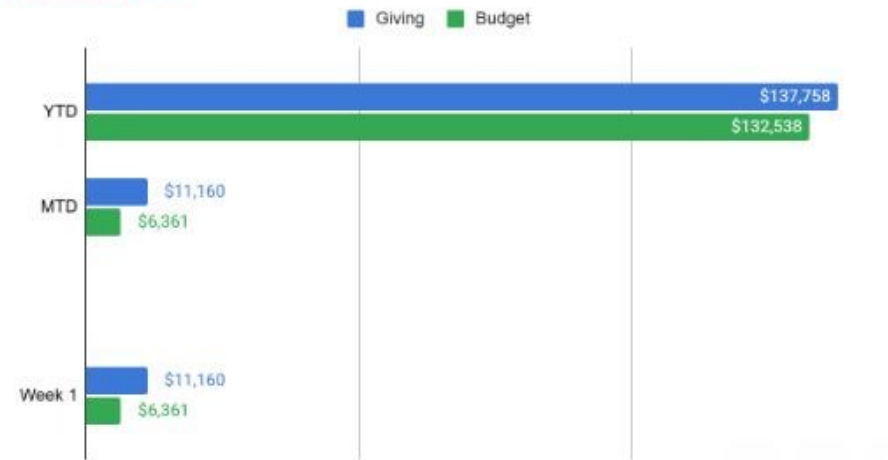
