Isaiah 35:1-10 (CEB)

¹The desert and the dry land will be glad; the wilderness will rejoice and blossom like the crocus. ²They will burst into bloom, and rejoice with joy and singing. They will receive the glory of Lebanon, the splendor of Carmel and Sharon. They will see the Lord's glory, the splendor of our God. ³Strengthen the weak hands, and support the unsteady knees.

⁴ Say to those who are panicking: "Be strong! Don't fear! Here's your God, coming with vengeance; with divine retribution God will come to save you." ⁵ Then the eyes of the blind will be opened, and the ears of the deaf will be cleared. ⁶ Then the lame will leap like the deer, and the tongue of the speechless will sing. Waters will spring up in the desert, and streams in the wilderness. ⁷ The burning sand will become a pool, and the thirsty ground, fountains of water. 
