OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- LOCATION We do not support paying for housing outside of Cherokee/Pickens County
- Homeless Migration We first try to get help from local agencies/VSO rather than have Veteran come to Cherokee/Pickens County
- VA benefits can help determine how long we support Veteran
- Family make-up Housing is targeted at Veteran ONLY No consideration for over 18 family members or significant other
- Divorce/Legal issues Does not make you homeless
- Failure to respond We have others who need help

OTHER CONSIDERATIONS

- Financial stability We look forward for ability to get back on own feet quickly – We are Temporary funding
 - Financial counseling Requirement for certain programs
 - 100% SC Disability does not support homelessness
- Special Considerations
 - MST This takes longer to address
 - Domestic Violence Work in Progress

State of Georgia Programs

- State of Georgia has some Housing program that Veterans can take advantage that are Federally funded but not specifically for Veterans:
 - 811
 - Housing Voucher program
- Managed and run by Georgia Department of Community Affairs and requires application process. Both programs as space and funding based so application is not guaranteed

811 Program

• HUD 811

What is HUD 811 Project Rental Assistance?

- HUD 811 PRA is a permanent supportive housing (PSH) program offering rental
 assistance and supportive services for people between the ages of 18 and 61 with longterm disabilities, who may have difficulty living successfully in the community and may
 become homeless or institutionalized without support. Housing supports are
 individualized and may include reminders to pay the rent, help to arrange medical
 appointments, and other services. Only people with disabilities who need these types of
 supports are eligible for HUD 811.
- The Georgia HUD 811 PRA program provides a set-aside of subsidized rental units at designated apartment buildings located around the state. Once an individual is referred and the application ahs been reviewed, a confirmation email will be sent to the Referral Agent. DCA will place the Referred Individual on a county-based housing list and will refer him/her to a property that has a vacancy in one of the requested counties when one becomes available. Position on the housing list is based on the date and time the referral was received by DCA.

GA Department of Community Affairs

Housing Choice Voucher

- The Housing Choice Voucher Program is a tenant-based rental assistance program that assists very low income individuals and families with renting safe, decent, and affordable dwelling units in the private rental market.
- The Housing Choice Voucher Program, also known as Section 8, is part of Georgia's comprehensive housing program administered by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA). The program is funded by the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD).
- The goals of the Housing Choice Voucher Program (HCV) are to:
- Provide improved living conditions for extremely low and low income individuals and families while maintaining their rent payments at an affordable level;
- Affirmatively further fair housing for individuals and families;
- Promote freedom of housing choice and integrate lower income and minority persons into mainstream society;
- Provide decent, safe, and affordable housing for eligible participants; and
- Provide an incentive to private property owners to rent to lower income persons by offering timely subsidy payments.
