Honoring Our Fallen Heroes on
Memorial Day

- **Buy a Poppy From the American Legion Auxiliary.** The organization has been selling red crepe-paper poppies for Memorial Day and Veterans Day since 1925. John McCrea's 1915 poem, *In Flanders Fields*, which honors those who died in World War I, inspired this tradition.
- **Display the American Flag.** On the morning of Memorial Day, raise the flag to the top of the staff before lowering it to half-staff. Leave it at half-staff until noon, when you can once again raise it to the top.
- **Visit a Veteran's Grave.** The Department of Veterans Affairs maintains 131 national cemeteries, and many states have veterans cemeteries as well.

Public or private? State and national parks tend to have simple campgrounds, but they often offer the best in natural beauty!

What about parking lots? Some shopping centers and truck stops will allow overnight camping, while rest areas generally prohibit it. Always be certain that you have permission to camp before setting up for the night.

The Family Motor Coach Association recommends the following if you stay in a private parking lot: Park out of the way, Avoid using slides & awnings, Don't use leveling jacks on asphalt, Limit stay to 1 night & leave cleaner than it was, make purchases as a thank-you, Don't put personal items outside.
