E.B.A. COMPETITIONS SUBSTITUTION OF PLAYERS

In the Pairs Competition the same players must compete throughout the County and National Competition. In the event of the illness (with certificate) or death of one of the players, substitution may be allowed of one who has not already competed in any Pair. Only one substitution may be allowed. The original player for whom substitution was made may return, but no further substitution may then be made.

In the Triples and Rink Competitions the same players must compete throughout the County and National Competitions unless satisfactory reasons can be submitted for substitution of not more than one player who has not already competed in these Competitions. The original player may be reinstated for subsequent games and the same substitute used for the same Triples or Rink, if again required.

These Rules will be Rigidly Enforced
