MEET JULIE REBOOT BERMAGUI

ReBoot is a celebration of community, movement and place, transforming Bermagui into a weekend hub of outdoor activity on the stunning Sapphire Coast. First held in 2014, ReBoot returns in October 2026 for its 12th annual event.

At its heart, ReBoot is about bringing people together through fun runs, ocean swims, a road bike ride, boot camp, Tug of War and mostly free Come and Try activities for all ages and abilities. "My favourite memories are when someone finishes their first ever run, swim or bike ride — the sheer joy of achievement," Julie says. "Seeing three generations of families competing together is very special."
