2027 Stitches in Time Quilt Show Guidelines

The Stitches in Time Quilt Show is open to the public with an admission price of \$5. **Show dates are March 17-20, 2027.** There are no fees for entering the quilt show. We can accept no more than **3 quilts per person.** **Note that each quilt must have a separate entry form.**

- **All entries must have a 4" sleeve sewn or pinned to the upper back of the quilt, edge to edge.**
- **Entries will be hung as space permits.** Efforts will be made to have all quilts in a category hung together, but this is subject to space. The Museum and Cultural Center @ Five Points, reserves the right to reject, recategorize or refuse to display any entry. The quilt show will be professionally judged before the start of the show, and all decisions of the judges are final.
 - A. **Vintage/Antique** - Quilts of any size are welcome in this category. Quilts must be at least 35 years old.
 - B. **Hand-Quilted** - Quilts in this category can be of any size. The quilt must be 100% hand quilted.
 - C. **Challenge** - The challenge pattern for 2027 is **Nine Patch**.
 - D. **Hand-Applique** – The applique work must be predominant over other techniques in amount and effect.
 - E. **Wall/Art** - This category is for smaller decorative pieces that are meant to be wall hangings. Quilts in this category can be no larger than 60 x 60. Can be pictorial or pieced.
 - F. **Youth/Novice**- Quilts in this category can be of any size. If you are over 17, this must be your first quilt.
 - G. **Small, Lap, Twin** - This category is for smaller bed quilts up to 60 X 90.
 - H. **Modern** – Sleek. Minimalist Design. Bold Colors. High Contrast. Innovation. Design and originality.
 - I. **Large quilts** - This category is for bed quilts from Full to King sized.
 - J. **Other** - This category is for non-traditional items. For example: Clothing, table toppers, pillows, etc.

Quilt Delivery

Quilts are only accepted via hand delivery. **Quilts will be accepted: Tuesday, March 2 - Friday, March 5, 2027, from 10-4 pm & Saturday, March 6, 2027, from 10-2pm.**

No quilts will be accepted after 2 pm on Saturday, March 6.

2. Bring with you a completed registration form for each entry.
3. Please mark the preferred method of quilt pick-up on your entry form above and follow the appropriate instructions listed below.

1. **Pick up times for quilts: Saturday, March 20, 2027, from 3:30- 4:00 pm, Tuesday-Friday, March 23-26 from 10-4 pm & Saturday, March 27 from 10-2pm**
2. You must pick up your quilt within the time period that you selected. Changes to pick up time will not be made on March 22 without extenuating circumstances and permission of Adam Romano, Curator of Arts Exhibits & Programming.
3. If your quilt is a winner and you have given permission for your quilt to stay on display until April 24, you will be able to pick up your quilt: **Tuesday, April 27, 10-4 pm**
