

Advent is my favorite season of the liturgical year. The Scriptures, the music, the candles, and the quiet beauty all draw me in and focus more intently on the great celebration of Christmas that is to come. We remember some great saints—Francis Xavier, Ambrose, Lucy—and two beautiful celebrations of our Blessed Mother—the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception and Our Lady of Guadalupe. All allow us to pause and remember God's goodness, quiet presence, and unwavering love.

I do pray that all of us in our Family of Parishes have used the Advent days to contemplate the mystery of God with us right now and his promise to come again in glory. There is a popular Christian song, "Evidence" by Josh Baldwin, which reminds us to always be mindful of God's presence in the daily routines of life:

I see the evidence of Your goodness
All over my life, all over my life
I see Your promises in fulfillment
All over my life, all over my life
Help me remember when I'm weak
Fear may come but fear will leave
You lead my heart to victory
You are my strength and You always will be

The Lord truly is present with us in remarkable ways—in our hearts when we pray, when we read the Sacred Scriptures, every time we celebrate the sacraments, in the beauty of creation, in the face of the poor, in the lives of our family and friends—we simply have to look for the 'evidence'.

We know that the surest way to 'find' the Lord is in the Blessed Sacrament—the Most Holy Eucharist. During this time of Eucharistic Revival, and especially as you look for Advent peace, I encourage you to spend some time before the Lord in Eucharistic adoration.
