**NEIGHBORHOOD SERVICES
JUNE IMPACT HIGHLIGHTS**

- **4,800+ pounds of fresh produce, meat, and grocery items** distributed thru our Neighborhood Produce Station, providing food support for downtown seniors and neighbors in need

- **1,500+ sandwiches shared** through Breakfast Ministry, Street Ministry, and Divine Mercy hour, bringing food, friendship, and compassionate presence directly to our unhoused neighbors

- **1,100 bottles of water distributed**, quenching thirsts and creating moments of conversation, connection, and community

- **250+ hot dogs served** thru OLGC sponsored Pop-Up Grills, turning the sidewalk into a place of hospitality, dignity, & encounter

- **400+ hygiene kits, socks, clothing items, and essential supplies distributed** to neighbors experiencing homelessness and poverty

- **Faith Community Nursing team** continued offering blood pressure checks, health education, resource navigation, and one-on-one care for neighbors with limited access to healthcare

- **Dental Station continued to build relationships with neighbors** through screenings, oral health education, and connections to ongoing dental support

- **40+ seniors engaged through SHARE, Healthy Topics, & Apha** gatherings which created spaces for friendship, wellness, faith formation, and deeper community

- **Pet food pantry** supporting our neighbors and their four-legged companions, helping to keep pets healthy and families together

Countless stories shared, prayers offered, relationships strengthened, and moments of hope experienced, reminding each neighbor that they are seen, known, and deeply loved by God

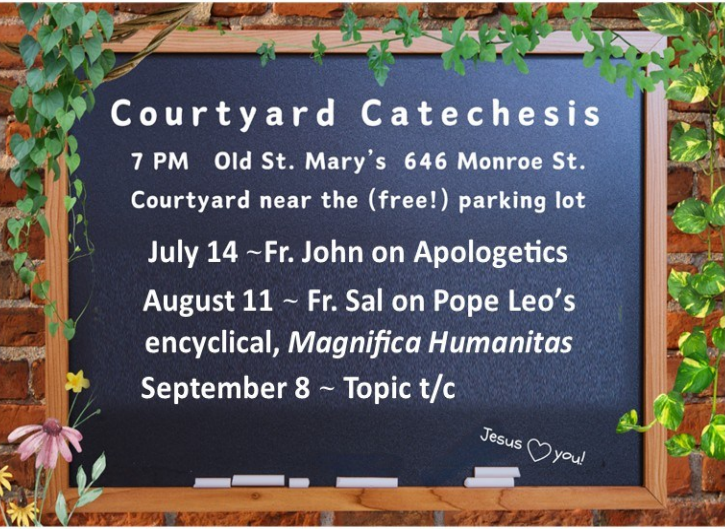
