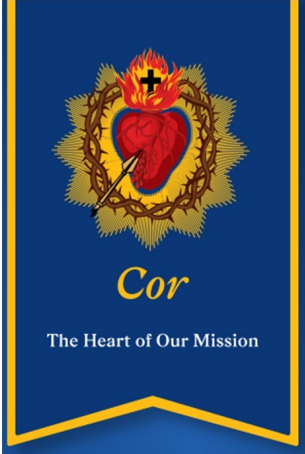


 **RISING**
