Dear Friends,

This weekend, as our nation pauses to celebrate the gift of freedom, the Church invites us to reflect on a deeper liberty — the freedom that comes not from independence, but from surrender.

It seems counterintuitive. A yoke, by definition, is a weight shared between two. And yet Jesus offers his yoke not as a burden but as a relief. The difference lies in who is carrying it with us.

Generosity is not a burden, but a liberating experience. It liberates because the generous person is walking in the yoke with Christ, sharing gifts and challenges alike. When we give — our time, our treasure, our presence to one another — we are not depleting ourselves. We are aligning ourselves with the One who said the burden would be light. And we find, often to our surprise, that he meant it.

On a weekend when we celebrate earthly freedom, it is worth asking: what truly sets us free? Not the absence of obligation, but the presence of love. Not the removal of the yoke, but the discovery that we are not pulling alone.

This summer, consider one way you might step more fully into that yoke — in your family, your parish, your community. Christ is already there, waiting.
