Scam Alert

Please be aware that any parish priest or staff member would **never** text or email you out of the blue to ask you to rescue us, buy something for us, or perform a secret task. Just delete the request. In general, none of us should ever click on links given to us when we are not expecting them, especially ones that seem to be made to alarm us. If you notice that the sender's name doesn't match his or her email address when hovering over it with your cursor, that's a big clue that something's amiss. Another clue is if the sender says something like 'please reply by email only - don't call' and gives an excuse like being in a meeting.
