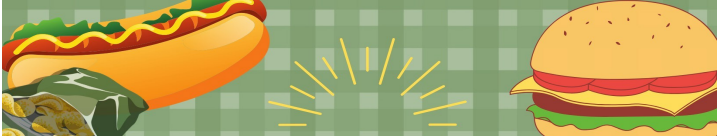

EVERYBODY'S CHURCH IN DOWNTOWN DETROIT

This weekend's Gospel reading (Matthew 18:21–35) features Peter asking Jesus how often he must forgive, prompting Jesus' radical reply of "seventy-seven times" and the Parable of the Unmerciful Servant. It challenges us to stop keeping score and extend boundless mercy, mirroring the infinite grace God gives us.

Here are some key themes to take with us:

- **Stop Counting:** Peter thought offering to forgive seven times was generous, but Jesus turns scorekeeping upside down.
- **The Parable of the Debtor:** A king forgives a servant's enormous, unpayable debt, yet that same servant refuses to forgive a tiny debt owed to him. When the king got wind of this, he was outraged and punished the servant. The lesson of this story is simple: The forgiveness God has extended to you must be extended to others. Pay it forward. After all, there is no amount of forgiveness you can give that will be greater than or equal to the amount of forgiveness God has forgiven you. If that is not enough motivation, listen to how Jesus sums up this story:
"This is how my heavenly Father will treat each of you unless you forgive your brother or sister from your heart" (Matthew 18:35).

Reflecting God's Mercy: We cannot hold tightly to the faults of others while living in the warmth of God's total forgiveness.

Points for Reflection

- **Releasing Resentment:** True Christian forgiveness does not pretend a wrong didn't happen; it refuses to let that wound permanently control your heart.
 - **Examining Our Grudges:** Where are you keeping a balance sheet of wrongs in your life?
- Living the Prayer:** Every time we pray the Lord's Prayer and ask to be forgiven as we forgive, we invite God to measure our mercy by the way we treat others.

Weekend Mass Parking at Park Rite Garage
St Aloysius parishioners and guests who attend weekend Mass may park for free in the Park Rite Garage beneath the Washington Park Apts. on Washington Blvd. After Mass, ask one of the ushers for a scan pass, then use it at the gate for full validation. This courtesy extends only to Sunday Mass, along with religious holidays, and parish related activities before or after Mass. It **does not** extend to sporting events or other activities unrelated to St. Aloysius, even if someone attends Mass that same day.
