## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y1-3:**

### **BBL-BIBLE STUDY COURSES**

BBL 100 – Old Testament Foundations is a systematic study of the Old Testament designed to provide a foundation.

BBL 101 – New Testament Pattern is a systematic survey of the New Testament. Each book of the New Testament is analyzed and related to the context of scripture as a whole.

BBL 102 – Holy Spirit Today is an in-depth study of the character and ministry of the Holy Spirit. Topics such as offending the Holy Spirit, receiving the Baptism of the Holy Spirit, the attributes of the Holy Spirit, and more will be covered.

BBL 103 – Power of Vision equips us in regarding establishing a clear vision for life and our ministries. Emphasis will be on wisdom, balance and strategy.

BBL 104 – Training for Reigning will be a study of the practical aspects of the Christian walk and how to walk with victory in every situation and with right attitudes.

BBL 105 – Ecclesiology - Church History is a study of the history and development of the New Testament Church. Students will study its origin, nature, offices, and government.

BBL 106 – Doctrine & Dispensationalism is a study for the student on what they believe and why they believe it, discussing the fundamentals of our faith.

BBL 107 – Eschatology - End Time Move discusses the end time move of God and the different schools of thought in regards to the second coming of Christ and signs of the end of the world.

BBL 108 – Deliverance – Setting the Captive Free delves into the ministry of the casting out of evil spirits. The scriptural basis for the ministry of deliverance will be taught.

BBL 109 – Cults & Occult is a study of the major cult religions in the world today and the effect of the occult in the earth and how Christians can effectively combat the ministry.

BBL 110 – Theology is a study of understanding God in our lives and what He desires to accomplish through us.

BBL 111 – God's Generals is a study of the great men and women of God who have gone before us in times past.

### **MGD – MATURITY, GROWTH AND DISCIPLINE COURSES**



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y1-3:(CONT'D):**

MGD 101 – Communion with God will teach you about the essence of communicating with God. Emphasis will be placed on biblical prayer, fasting and listening to the Father's voice.

MGD 102 – Family Life Principles studies the interrelationship and responsibilities of members of a Christian Home.

MGD 103 – Stewardship, Finances and Prosperity provides an understanding of the Christian Life in the area of finances and stewardship of all that God has entrusted to us. Emphasis will be placed on biblical financial strategies and on the Word.

MGD 104 – Mentoring, Fathering and Discipleship (Discipleship) is a study on how to nurture and care for those placed in our care and an in-depth look at interdependence and needing one another.

MGD 105 – Armor Bearer - Serving and Attitudes is an in-depth study of serving and the heart attitudes that are necessary to serve. This is an excellent class to shape our hearts to serve.

### **MIN – MINISTRY COURSES INVOLVING HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE**

MIN 100 – Spiritual Gifts is an intensive look at God's gifts for the Church. Students will learn about the gifts available for every believer to make one a greater blessing to the Church and more effective in evangelism.

MIN 101 – Gift of the Apostle is an in-depth study of the office of the Apostle. Emphasis will be upon the life and ministry of the Apostle.

MIN 102 – Prophets and the Prophetic Ministry is an in-depth study of the office of the Prophet. Emphasis will be upon the life and ministry of the Prophet.

MIN 103 – Spirit Life Counseling (Inner Healing) is a study of biblical methods of counseling. Emphasis will be upon soul healing techniques and the use of spiritual gifts in healing the heart.

MIN 104 – Dynamic Communications - Practical Ministry a study in the practice of sermon preparation, preparatory techniques and practicing communication skills. The student will prepare and deliver a short message and perform a wedding and funeral.

MIN 105 – Restoring the Arts examines the arts and tools for evangelism. This course takes a look at methods, motives, attitudes, techniques and testimonies in the present day truths.

### **CLS – CHRISTIAN LIFE SERVICE COURSES CREATING THE HEART OF A SERVANT**



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y1-3:(CONT'D):**

CLS 100 – The Power of Intercession is an intensive study on the power of prayer with particular emphasis on intercessory prayer for the corporate body and individuals.

CLS 101 – Silencing the Enemy - Praise and Worship is a study of New Testament worship with emphasis on warfare praise and the power of Praise and Worship.

CLS 102 – Warfare Strategies - Taking The City is an examination of warfare prayer both individually and corporately. Strategies will be examined specifically for intercessors to discern spirits over a geographical region and how to take a city for God.

CLS 103 – New Testament Church Government Ministries and Offices is a study of the New Testament Church and its functions, Church government, the offices of Elder and Deacon each from the context of its functions in the Body of Christ. The five-fold ministry is defined and developed.

### **LCD – LOCAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT COURSES STUDYING THE LOCAL CHURCH**

LCD 100 – Children and Youth is a class focusing on how to reach children and youth effectively. Curriculum, ideas, and different speakers contribute to this class.

LCD 101 - Missions Methods will be a study of the work of missions both foreign and local. There will be an opportunity to be a part of foreign missions trips.

LCD 102 – Church Growth Equipping and Releasing is a course in understanding the active ministry in the New Testament Church. Emphasis is placed on activation of different ministries to include praise and worship teams, cell groups, as well as child, youth and college groups.

LCD 103 – Angelology is a study that will focus on the ministry and function of holy, elect angels of God.

### **PRA – PRACTICUM COURSES**

PRA 100 – Cell Life – Church Planting is a study in biblical mentoring and relationships (students will have the opportunity to be placed with prospective mentoring groups).

PRA 101 – Evangelism Now is a study of evangelism methods of reaching people with the gospel of Jesus Christ.

PRA 102 – Counseling and Personal Ministry is a class involving the ministry of prophetic counseling and inner healing techniques.

PRA 103 – Church Law – Ethics, Policies & Procedures is a class studying the law and how it applies to the Church.

PRA 104 – Bookkeeping & Accounting – Non-Profit Ministry is a study of what it takes to properly set up your ministry, as well as practical aspects of books, office administration, receptionist accountability, etc.



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y4-5:**

### **BBL-BIBLE STUDY COURSES**

BBL 201 - Manners & Customs & Culture - Israel will involve the study of manners and customs of early biblical times that will provide insight into the culture of the day.

BBL 202 - Christology – Life of Christ will provide an in-depth study into the life of Jesus and his ministry.

BBL 203 - Hermeneutics will study the principles of hermeneutics and how they are mentioned and developed in the Word of God.

BBL 204 - Christian Apologetics & Comparative Religions will study more intensely what we believe and why we believe it. Comparison will be made between Christology and other religions and why Christology is the one true religion.

BBL 205 - Greek will provide a study in basic Greek for the student.

BBL 206 - Hebrew will provide a study in basic Hebrew for the student.

BBL 207 - Biblical Archaeology, Geography & Anthropology will provide a study into archaeology and geography for biblical times and now.

### **CLS – CHRISTIAN LIFE SERVICE**

CLS 201 - Leadership Maxims will study the principles of leadership. The student will gain insight into the importance of integrity, responsibility, and becoming a genuine leader in kingdom work.

## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y4-5:(CONT'D):**

### **MIN – MINISTRY COURSES INVOLVING HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE**

MIN 201 - Sacerdotal Functions will involve an in-depth study into the responsibilities of a licensed/ordained minister, such as weddings, funerals, premarital counseling, etc.

MIN 202 - Faith, Healing & Miracles will study the importance of faith and the gifts of healing and miracles. By studying other “greats” in the kingdom, the student will be encouraged and strengthened.

### **PRA – PRACTICUM**

PRA 201- Pre-Marital Ministry & Pastoral Care will guide the student on the how-to's of counseling couples who are engaged. Students will learn techniques of counseling.

### **LCD – LOCAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT**

LCD 201- Praise & Worship II will provide an in-depth study into Praise and Worship for the local church. The relationship between the Pastor and Worship Leaders will be discussed.



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y4-5:(CONT'D):**

### **BBL-BIBLE STUDY COURSES**

BBL 208 - Dreams, Visions & Symbols will involve the study of dreams and visions. The student will examine symbols and their meanings.

BBL 209 - Demons, Deliverance & Me will be a further look at the meaning of deliverance.

### **CLS – CHRISTIAN LIFE SERVICE**

CLS 202 - Relationships, Recovery & Self Help will study relationships and how to maintain healthy relationships. Students will study healthy communications.

CLS 203 - Holiness & Sanctification will study holiness in the life of the believer. The student will also study the process of sanctification.

CLS 204 - Missions & Martyrs will study missions and those who have lived the life of martyrdom.

### **ENG – ENGLISH**

ENG 101- Seminary English will study English grammar and its rules.

### **MIN – MINISTRY COURSES INVOLVING HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE**

MIN 203 - Homiletics will be a further study of the art of preaching and teaching.

MIN 204 - Apostles & Prophets will study the ministries of Apostles and Prophets. The student will examine the Apostolic move of God.

MIN 205 - Miracles, Signs & Wonders will examine the history of miracles, signs, and wonders. The student will look at those who have gone through history.

### **PRA – PRACTICUM**

PRA 202 - Comparative Counseling will be a further study in counseling and techniques.

## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y4-5 (CONT'D):**

### **MGD – MATURITY, GROWTH, AND DISCIPLINE COURSES**

MGD 101 - Biblical Economics & Stewardship will do an in depth study of Biblical economics. The student will also learn about budgeting.

MGD 102 - Spiritual Maturity & Authority will study the mechanics of our walk with God and maturity. The student will study the authority of the believer.



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y6-7:**

### **BBL-BIBLE STUDY COURSES**

BBL 210 - Major Prophets - Messages" will do an in depth study of the Major Prophets and their messages. The student will study the Major Prophets' lives and what their messages were to the people.

BBL 211 - Gospels - Exegesis involves the deep study of the Gospels as seen by the four different authors. The student will do comparative study of the four Gospels and expound on the life and teachings of Jesus.

BBL 212 - Pneumatology – Acts & Holy Spirit involves the study of the work of the Holy Spirit. Students will explore the character of the Holy Spirit in the Book of Acts and how His work relates to the past, present, and future.

BBL 213 - Israel's Tabernacle Secrets will perform an in depth study of the Tabernacle. Students will explore the symbolism behind the study of the Tabernacle.

BBL 214 - Minor Prophets - Messages will study the Minor Prophets and what they preached. Students will examine each book of the Minor Prophets and their messages.

BBL 215 – General & Pauline Epistles will examine the General and Pauline Epistles and their messages. Students will examine the principles of each epistle.

### **CLS – CHRISTIAN LIFE SERVICE**

CLS 205 - Missiology will explore the study of Missiology and the development of the Church throughout history and the different moves of God.

### **MIN – MINISTRY COURSES INVOLVING HANDS-ON EXPERIENCE**

MIN 206 - Soul Winning & Revival involves the study of evangelism for the present day church. Students will explore methods and techniques for soul winning and will look at former revivals. They will also explore the present day revival of the church.

### **PRA – PRACTICUM**

PRA 203 - Divorce, Remarriage & Single Life - Pastoral Care will study the effects of divorce, remarriage, and returning to single life. Students will learn wisdom to counsel those going through these traumatic changes in the seasons of life.

PRA 204 - Substance Abuse Counseling – Compulsive Behavior will be a study in counseling those that are victims of substance abuse. Various techniques and methods will be examined. Students will look at the characteristics and mindsets of compulsive behaviors.



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y6-7:(CONT'D):**

### **LCD – LOCAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT**

LCD 202 - Worship Arts III is a continuation study of the Arts in worship. Students will explore contemporary arts that can be and are being used in the church.

### **MGD – MATURITY, GROWTH, AND DISCIPLINE COURSES**

MGD 103 - Practical Financial Wisdom is designed to take the student to the place of having wisdom in their finances and to be able to give wisdom to others for their finances. Students will gain understanding in biblical economics.

### **BBL-BIBLE STUDY COURSES**

BBL 216 - Pentateuch – Law & Grace will examine the study of the law and compare it to God's grace. Students will see the progression of the law in the Old Testament and grace in the New Testament through a thorough study of the Word.

BBL 217 - Revelation & Daniel - Tutorial will study these books of the Bible with a view to compare the messages of both books and how it relates to present day Christianity.

BBL 218 - Historical Books will analyze the historical books of the Bible and examine how Christ is revealed through history and how we see some of the same events repeat themselves today.

BBL 219 - John's Writings will study the writings of John and his message. Highlights of each book will be examined

BBL 220 - Poetical Books – Revealed will look in depth at the poetical books. Students will see Christ revealed and the deep things of God revealed through Bible poetry.

BBL 221 - Apocrypha - Tutorial will study the "uncanonized" books of the Bible. This class will examine these books from a historical view to gain greater in-depth revelation.

### **PRA – PRACTICUM**

PRA 205 - Nouthetic I – Advanced Inner Healing involves the study of the concepts of this type of counseling – a method or technique of soul healing. This is an introductory level course.

PRA 206 - Nouthetic II – Advanced Inner Healing will continue the in-depth study of inner healing taking the student into more detail of how the technique works.

CDM- Zero credit capstone course to assist students with completing their doctoral discourse for the Doctorate of Ministry. The doctoral discourse will discuss the 150 field experience/ volunteer hours.

CDD- Zero credit capstone course to assist students with completing their doctoral dissertation for the Doctorate of Divinity in Theological Studies. The doctoral dissertation will discuss the research topic of choice in a 150 page academic publication.



## **COURSE DESCRIPTIONS Y6-7:(CONT'D):**

PRA 207 - Nouthetic III – Advanced Inner Healing will delve into the practice of inner healing and what to do with difficult cases - how to treat them, what to do, and how to lead the person to their healing.

PRA 208 - Nouthetic IV – Advanced Inner Healing is the advanced class that will examine the more in depth process of Nouthetic Counseling and compare it with other forms of soul healing.

PRA – 209 Death, Dying & Bereavement – Pastoral Care will study the process of death and grieving. Students will learn to counsel those who go through the grieving process and loss.

### **LCD – LOCAL CHURCH DEVELOPMENT**

LCD 203 - Church Administration – Structure & Education will look in depth at what it takes to run a church. Students will study practical guidelines as well as guidelines for church pastoral care.
