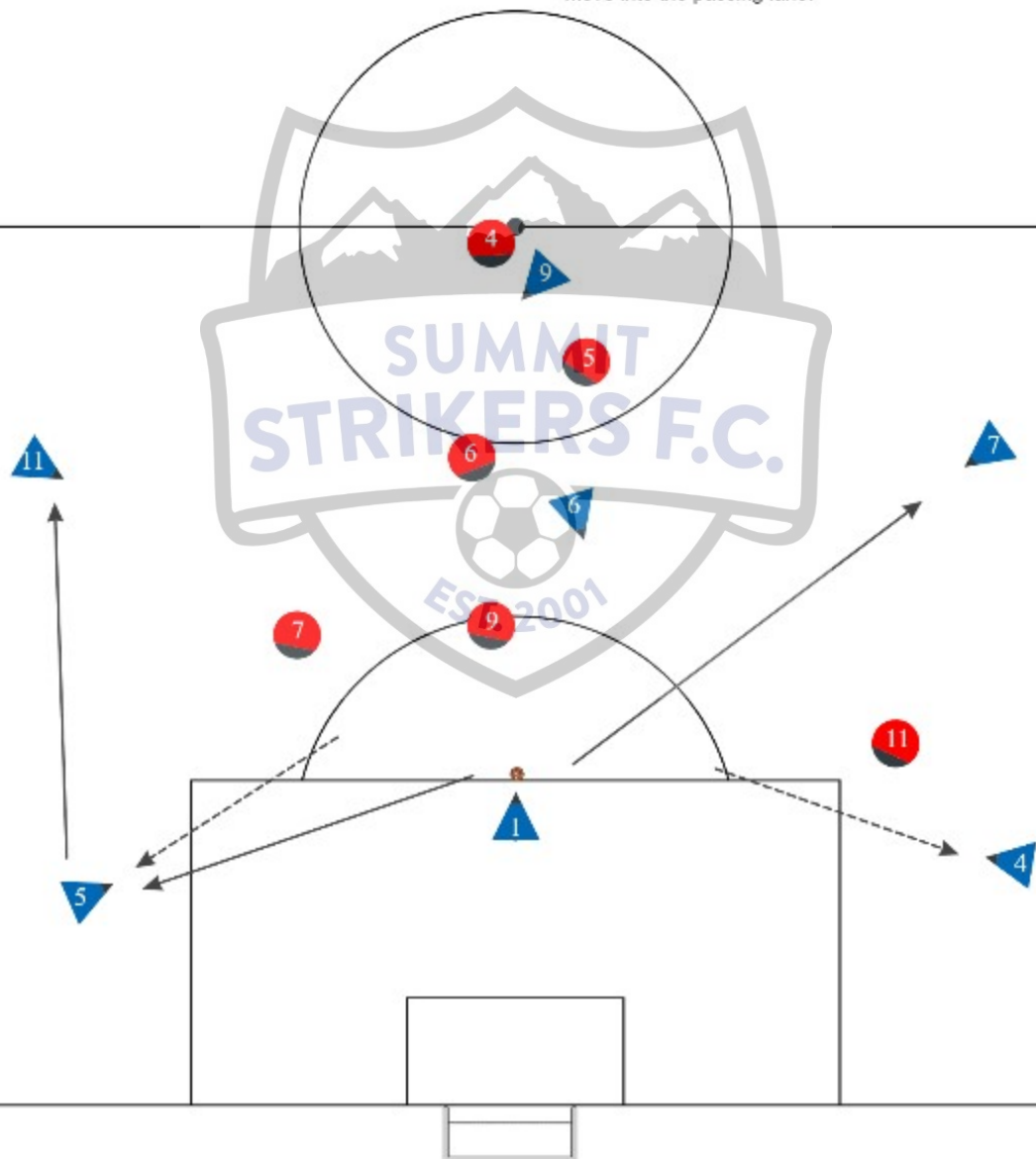


## 7v7 Possession Goal Kick

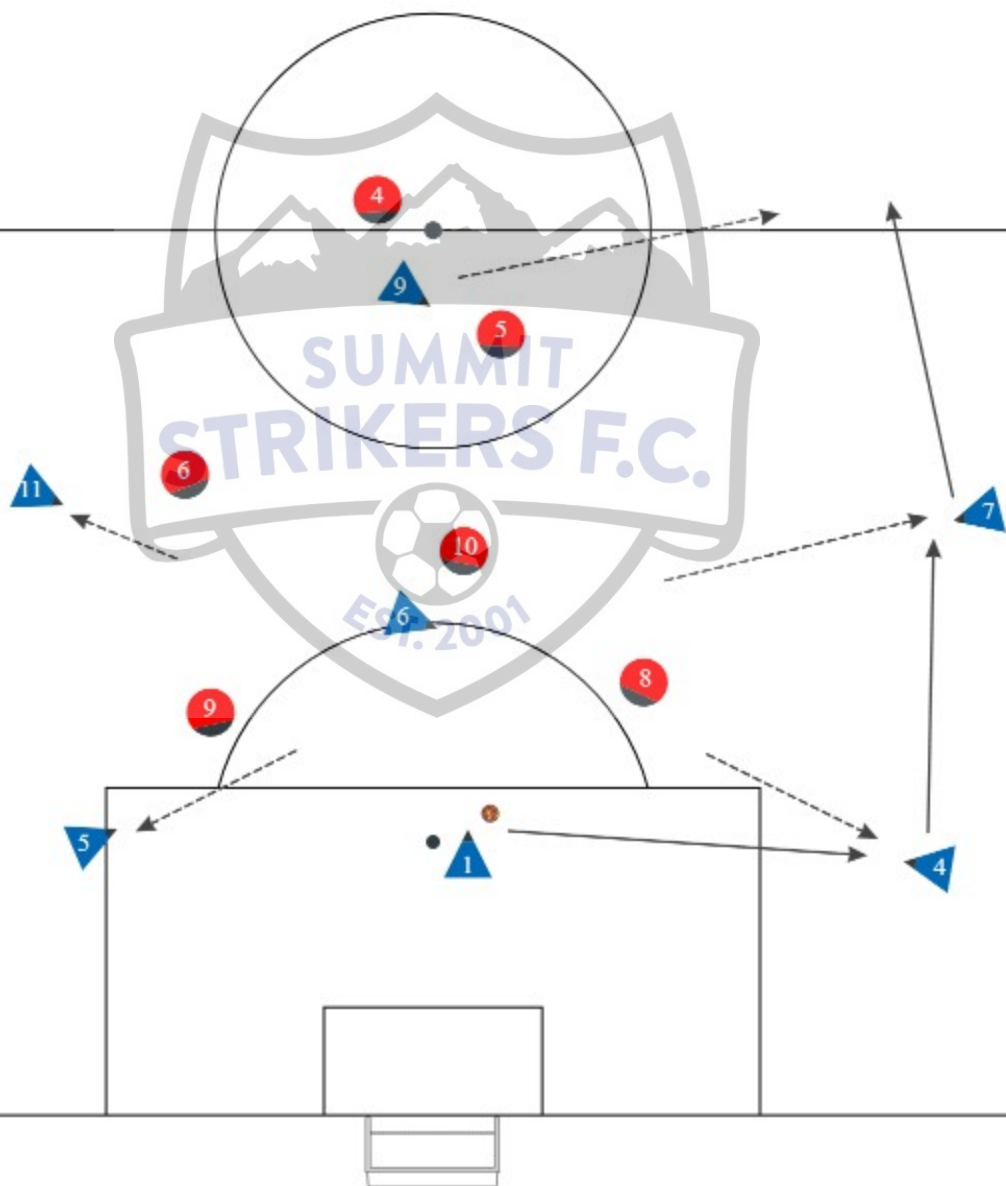


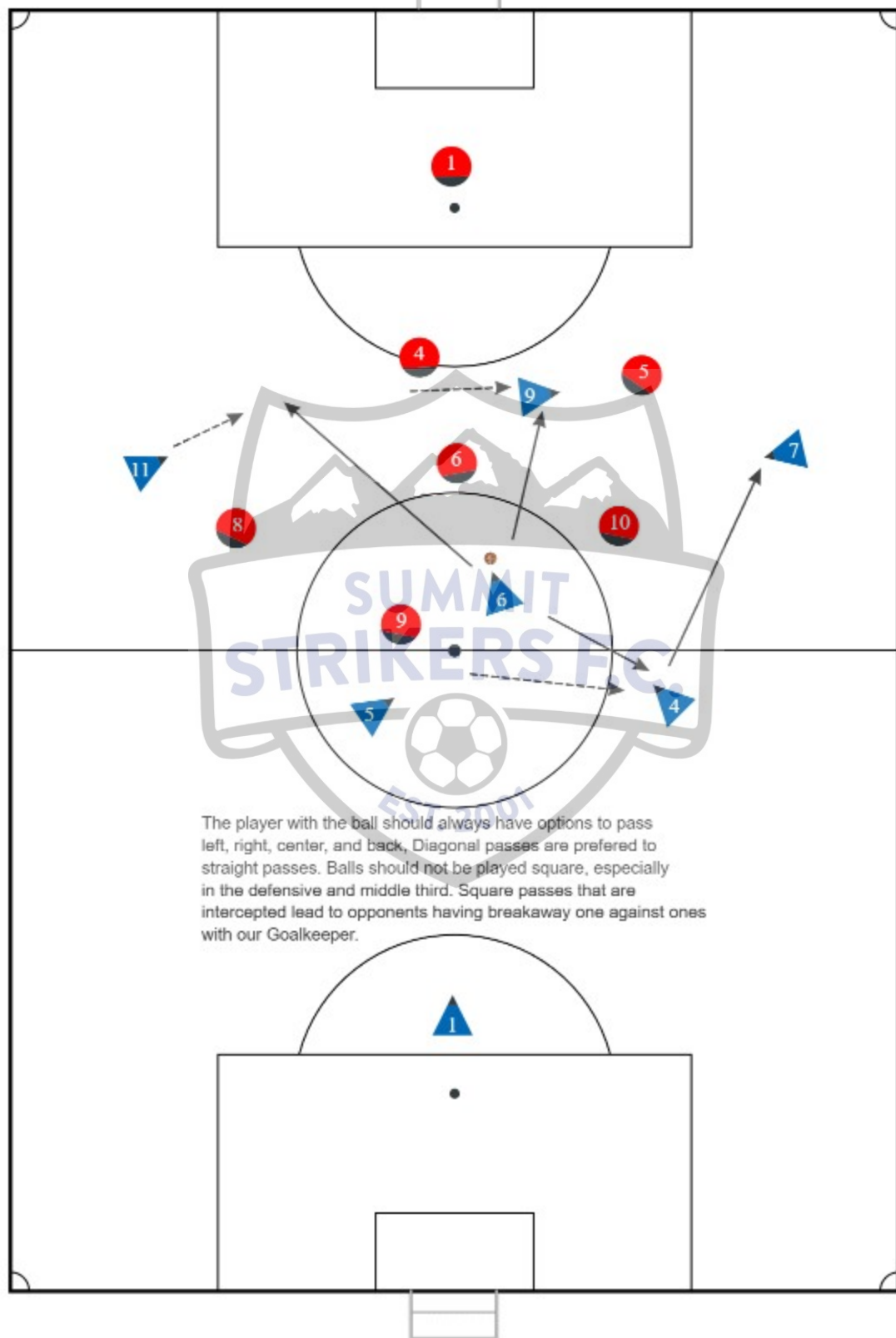
#4 and #5 drop and go wide. If #4 or #5 are marked play #7 or #11. Leave the passing lanes open by not having players too close together. If the opponent marks #4, #5, #7 and #11, then #6 should be open. #6 needs to stay out of the direct passing lane of #7, so no opponents move into the passing lane.



## 7v7 Possession Ball in the Goalkeepers Hand

#4 and #5 drop and go wide. #7 and # 11 move wide on the flanks. #6 finds space in the middle. # 9 waits to see where the ball is played, and then moves to open space to receive the next pass.





The player with the ball should always have options to pass left, right, center, and back. Diagonal passes are preferred to straight passes. Balls should not be played square, especially in the defensive and middle third. Square passes that are intercepted lead to opponents having breakaway one against ones with our Goalkeeper.
