- X-Rays
- Cleanings
- Fluoride Treatments
- Fillings
- Extractions
- And Other Same Day Treatments

Important: Only same-day treatments are available. Due to time constraints, care will be prioritized based on the most critical needs.

Event Details

- Clinic doors open at 7:30AM
- Treatment ends at 1:00PM
- Services are provided on a first-come, first-served basis
- There will be media coverage, if you do not feel comfortable please let a volunteer know

We strongly encourage patients to arrive early, as treatment capacity is limited and may fill quickly.

How Entry Process Works (For Patients)

1. When you arrive, enter the line outside
2. Patients will be taken inside by a volunteer in small waves for evaluation and treatment

Waiting Options

- There is no indoor waiting area
- All patients will wait outside the clinic
 - If there is bad weather, we will implement a ticket system to be able to call patients
- This policy ensures fairness for all patients

Parking & Facilities

- Parking lot does not have heated or cooled shelter
- For bathroom emergencies, flag down a volunteer and they will escort you to a restroom

What to Bring

Please come prepared for a wait:

- Water and snacks
- A list of all medicates (names and dosages)
 - Continue taking medications as directed
- Weather-appropriate clothing
- Blankets and insulated layers (coats, gloves, hat) if cold
- Phone and battery if needed

Important Notes

- Free dental services are limited and may fill early
- Arrive early for the best chances of being seen
