### 10 a.m. Service of Holy Eucharist

This is a communion service with full choir and music. When Church School is scheduled, children are encouraged to attend starting at 9:50 am and lasting through the Lessons, Gospel and sermon (until approximately 10:40 a.m.). After Church School, they are led into the service at the Peace so that they can share Holy Communion with their families and community. When Church School is not scheduled, families are encouraged to bring their children to the service. Please join our coffee hour in the Parish Hall immediately after the service for delicious refreshments!

### Worshipping with your child

Children are an integral part of the community's worship life. Young children learn about worship by participating in it. Picture books, children's worship bulletins, materials for quiet play, paper and markers are helpful resources for busy hands. These may be found on the shelves in the rear of the church.

Once children are old enough, they are encouraged to help lead worship by serving as an acolyte, or by singing in the choir. On select Sundays, the entire 10 am service is especially designed for child and youth participation and features a children's sermon.

Each Sunday, everyone is invited to the altar rail to receive either Holy Communion or a blessing from a Priest. Adults and children who prefer to receive a blessing are asked to cross their hands over their chest.

### **Special Holidays and Celebrations**

A variety of special celebrations and activities geared towards families and children take place throughout the year. Families reconnect at Sundae Sunday (September 14) and backpacks are blessed at the Blessing of the Backpacks (September 21). Pets and stuffed animals alike are blessed during the Blessing of the Animals (October 5). Additional opportunities for fellowship include the Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper (February 17), Choral Evensong – Marie Stultz Memorial Concert (May 31), and other family activities throughout the year.

### **Christian Formation for Children**

CHURCH SCHOOL Pre-K through 5th Grade

9:50 a.m. – 10:40 a.m. Our Church School is a thriving community!

Currently, all children in grades Pre-K-5 are invited to participate in Church School that takes place in the Education Wing on Sunday mornings. Families may sign in their children at 9:50 a.m. The lesson will be led by two parent volunteers. Parents with younger toddlers and babies may attend with their children. The children are then led into the church to join their families for Holy Communion at approximately 10:40 a.m.

The main approach to children's formation used at Christ Church is the Montessori-based *Godly Play* program, a curriculum of spiritual practice exploring the mystery of God's presence in our lives. The Godly Play curriculum engages children in what is most exciting about religious education: God inviting them into Scripture and spiritual experience, modeling the worship life, stories, symbols, and rituals of Christian congregations.
