### OFFICIAL RULES

Team Marathon Società Sportiva Dilettantistica a responsabilità limitata, affiliated with the Italian Athletics Federation (FIDAL) with code TO271 in association with the Fondazione Piemontese per la Ricerca sul Cancro (hereinafter jointly "the Organizing Committee"), with the approval of FIDAL organize the sixth edition of the Torino Half Marathon, officially named "Torino City Half Marathon," an international road running event over the distance of 21.097 km.

### ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATIONS

By registering for the TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON, the athlete declares that he/she knows in its entirety and unconditionally accepts these regulations as well as being aware that participating in the TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON and/or sporting events in general is potentially a risky activity. The athlete further declares that he/she assumes all risks arising from his/her participation in the event: falls, contact with vehicles, with other participants, spectators or others, weather conditions, traffic and road conditions, any kind of risk well known and assessed. By submitting the online registration form, the athlete releases and discharges the Organizers of all present and future claims or liabilities of any kind, as well as for damages to persons and/or property, known or unknown, resulting from his/her participation in the event, not attributable to the organizing committee.

Participation in the races implies by registered participants' unreserved acceptance of these regulations, in all their parts. Competitors are also obliged to comply with the Highway Code exceeded the time limit. By registering, each participant agrees to abide by these Rules and Regulations and releases the organizers from any civil or criminal liability for any accident

or incident, for damage to persons or property caused to him or by himself, which may occur during the event, not attributable to the organizer.

**IMPORTANT NOTES:** By registering for the TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON, each athlete declares under his/her own responsibility that he/she has verified that his/her FIDAL - RUNCARD STANDARD OR EPS - WORLD ATHLETICS license (Ex IAAF) and the COMPETITIVE medical certificate for ATHLETICS - HEALTH FORM membership is valid on the date of the event.

If the requirements are not verified by the athlete or the club to which the registrant belongs, the registrant agrees to update them, or have them updated, by the date of the event. No refund will be issued by the organizer if the enrollee is found to be in default of the above specifications.

By registering for the TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON, the participant declares that he/she is not aware of any past medical conditions or injuries that may place him/her at risk during the event.

The athlete also self-certifies the non-existence of sports, civil and/or criminal sanctions for doping, and declares that he/she has not taken - and does not take - substances included in the World Antidoping Agency (WADA) anti-doping list. It is reminded that, according to current federal regulations, competitors may be subject to doping controls by the competent authorities.

## COMPLIANCE WITH HEALTH PROTECTION REGULATIONS

Each participant registered for the TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON undertakes, upon registration, to comply with the health protection regulations (ordinary and/or extraordinary) in force on the date of the event, including the provisions issued through specific Decreti-Legge (D.L.) and/or Decrees of the President of the Council of Ministers (D.P.C.M.).

## NORMS OF PARTICIPATION

With reference to the provisions of the Rules for the Organization of Events (Article 34) issued by the Italian Athletics Federation, all athletes aged 18 years and over (thousandth of age) who belong to one of the following categories may take part in the event:

### 1 – ITALIAN ATHLETES, FOREIGN ATHLETES AND ATHLETES RESIDENT IN ITALY (competitive section)

- **Members of Athletics Clubs (S.S.D./A.S.D.) affiliated with FIDAL in 2026**, belonging to the categories "Juniore" (18-19 years old), "Promesse" (20-22 years old) and "Seniores" (23-34 years old) and "Master" (SM/SF35, SM/SF40, SM/SF45, SM/SF50, SM/SF55, SM60/SF60 and over, SM70 and

over), with a COMPETITIVE medical certificate for ATHLETICS valid on the date of the event;

- **Members of Athletics Clubs (S.S.D./A.S.D.) affiliated with a Sports Promotion Authority (EPS)** that has signed an agreement with FIDAL in 2026 (athletics discipline) or individual members (the card is issued directly by the relevant EPS Committee), who are in possession of RUNCARD EPS ([www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com)) and the COMPETITIVE medical certificate for ATHLETICS valid on the date of the event (the certificate must be uploaded on the registration form, or delivered to the Organizing Committee no later than 10 days before the date of the competition);

- **NON-MEMBERS of Athletics Clubs (S.S.D./A.S.D.) affiliated with FIDAL or a Sports Promotion Authority** that has signed an agreement with FIDAL in 2026, who are in possession of RUNCARD STANDARD ([www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com)) and the COMPETITIVE medical certificate for ATHLETICS valid on the date of the event (the certificate must be uploaded online on the registration form, or emailed to [iscrizioni@torinocitymarathon.it](mailto:iscrizioni@torinocitymarathon.it) no later than 10 days after the date of the competition);

## 2 - ITALIAN AND FOREIGN ATHLETES AND ATHLETES NOT RESIDENT IN ITALY (competitive section)

- **MEMBERS of foreign Athletics Clubs and Federations, affiliated with WORLD ATHLETICS (ex. IAAF)** for the 2026 sports season, belonging to the categories Juniores, Promesse (20-22 years old) and Seniores (23-34 years old), Master (SM/SF35, SM/SF40, SM/SF45, SM/SF50, SM/SF55, SM60/SF60 and over, SM70 and over).

N.B. Non-EU athletes must have a residence permit or be in possession of an entry visa.

# TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON

- ITALIAN CITIZENS residing abroad who are not members of any foreign athletics clubs or federations affiliated with WORLD ATHLETICS (formerly IAAF), and who meet the following requirements:
  - A STANDARD RUNCARD valid on the date of the event (which can be obtained from the website [www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com));
  - a medical certificate of fitness for competitive athletics, valid on the date of the event (the certificate must be uploaded online via the registration form, or submitted to the Organising Committee no later than 10 days before the competition takes place);
- FOREIGN NATIONALS, resident abroad, not registered with foreign athletics clubs or federations affiliated to WORLD ATHLETICS (formerly IAAF), must meet the following requirements:

- A valid STANDARD RUNCARD on the date of the event (available to sign up on the website [www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com));
- MEDICAL CERTIFICATE of fitness for competitive ATHLETICS, valid on the date of the event (the certificate must be completed by a doctor in the athlete's country of residence and uploaded online via the registration form, or submitted to the Organising Committee no later than 10 days before the date of the competition);

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE: the medical certificate must meet all the requirements set by the Italian Athletics Federation.

### 3 - RUNNERS FOR TOURIST SPORTING GOALS

From 2019, following the Federal resolution, RUNNERS FOR TOURIST SPORTING GOALS registration has been allowed only and exclusively for foreign citizens, non-members, residing abroad who come to Italy for tourist-sporting reasons.

For this type of participant is expected to start in the grids prepared for the competitive race, according to the time declared during registration,

wearing dedicated identification bibs, but will not be included in the official rankings and will not participate in the prize money (whether it consists of prizes in kind or money).

When collecting the bib number, the participant must present a copy of their ID/passport and hand in the duly signed release form, which can be downloaded from the following link: [CLICK HERE](#)

## IMPORTANT NOTE FOR TRIATHLETES

TRIATHLETES can participate only and exclusively with FIDAL RUNCARD STANDARD or RUNCARD EPS.

We remind you that the competitive medical certificate valid on the date of the event must state the discipline "ATHLETICS".

The competitive medical certificate for only the discipline of "TRIATHLON" will not be considered valid because it pertains exclusively to the Italian Triathlon Federation.

## PARTICIPATION OF ATHLETES IN THE ELITE CATEGORY'

With reference to Rule 1 of the RTI, ELITE athletes are considered to be male participants whose bib numbering falls between No. 5.001 and No. 5.050 and female participants whose bib numbering falls between No. 5.051 and No. 5.100 (inclusive).

## REGISTRATION FEES

- Free registration for disabled people in the wheelchair category registered with C.I.P. - FISPE members (by 1<sup>st</sup> November 2026);

- 30 euros – valid from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026;
- 35 euros – valid from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2026;
- 40 euros – valid from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2026;
- 55 euros – valid from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 20<sup>th</sup> November 2026;
- 50 euros – valid from 27<sup>th</sup> November to 28<sup>th</sup> November at the Torino City Marathon Village;

**N.B.** Registration for the Torino City Half Marathon will be suspended from 21<sup>st</sup> November to 26<sup>th</sup> November 2026 and will resume at the Torino City Marathon Village from 27 November from 10:00 a.m. to 28 November 2026, at 8:00 p.m.

## REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT METHODS

- Online at Endu.net (until 23:59 on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2026) - payment by credit cards (except AMEX circuit), direct bank transfer;

NB: Registration by the latter mode incurs additional fees.

- At the Torino City Marathon Village on the following days and times (payment by cash, pos or satispay)
  - Friday, 27<sup>th</sup> November 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.;
  - Saturday, 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.;

## CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION

You will be able to check the status of your registration by following the directions provided at [www.torinocitymarathon.it](http://www.torinocitymarathon.it). Bib numbers will be assigned close to the race: a few days before the race, all duly registered athletes will receive an e-mail communication valid as an official "confirmation letter." This e-mail will contain all the basic instructions for collecting the bib number and participating in the race. It is not necessary to print a hard copy of the e-mail itself; it will be possible to present it on a device such as a smartphone or tablet.

## BIB NUMBER DISTRIBUTION AND TECHNICAL GADGETS

Bibs will be distributed at the Torino City Marathon Village on the following days and times:

- Friday 27 November 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.;
- Saturday 28 November 2026, from 10:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.;

Documents required for bib pickup:

## ITALIAN ATHLETES

- FIDAL card (paper/digital coupon issued by their own club) or FIDAL RUNCARD STANDARD or EPS card;
- For RUNCARD STANDARD or EPS holders copy of MEDICAL AGONISTIC CERTIFICATE for LIGHT ATHLETICS (in case color copy was not provided during registration);
- ID or proxy for collection or copy of payment.

## FOREIGN ATHLETES

- Card issued by the foreign Athletics Federation to which they belong or FIDAL RUNCARD STANDARD card;
- For RUNCARD STANDARD holders copy of HEALTH FORM (in case copy was not provided at registration);
- ID or proxy for pick-up or copy of payment.

## BAG TRANSPORT AND STORAGE SERVICE

Participants will be able to drop off their bags with their clothing on special vehicles, located in the immediate vicinity of the start area, and pick them up at the finish area when the race is over. The organization accepts no responsibility for any loss of valuables and/or money.

---

## SHUTTLE SERVICE

Participants in the event will be able to use the shuttle service provided by the Organizing Committee. Athletes will be able to leave their vehicles at the finish area and use the pre-race shuttle service to reach the start area.

Vehicle schedules and pick-up locations will be announced close to the date of the event.

## REFRESHMENTS

Refreshment points will be present every 5 km:

- Refreshments at the 5 km and 10 km - Water
  - Refreshments at the 15 km - Water, Supplements and solid food.

## TIMING SYSTEM

The race will be timed by EvoData and official and actual times will be recorded.

---

## RANKING

All competitors will receive the chip, already pre-positioned on the bib number. 2 time controls will be placed, respectively at the 10 km plus a surprise one (useful for the detection of "cuts" on the route), and the following rankings will be drawn up:

- General finishing order calculated on the basis of the official time.
  - GENERAL rankings;
  - CATEGORY rankings;
  - NUMEROUS ASD/SSD rankings.

## OFFICIAL AWARDS CEREMONY

The official award ceremonies will begin at 11:30 a.m.; the first three women and the first three men of the GENERAL ranking, the first three women and the first three ITALIAN men of the GENERAL ranking will be awarded on stage. All other finishers and numerous companies will be able to view the rankings published on Endu.net and go to the booth adjacent to the stage to pick up their prize directly.

**Please note:** Unclaimed prizes will not be sent home and no communication, written or verbal, will be given to winners about their non-collection. Category prizes not collected during the event awards will no longer be delivered.

## PACER SERVICE

Pacemakers will be available to athletes and recognizable through a personalized bib and balloon on which their respective times will be indicated.

## MEDAL AND CERTIFICATE OF PARTICIPATION

All finishers will receive a TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON participation medal on the finish line and can print their official participation certificate on Endu.net

---

## PHOTOTODAY SERVICE

With Phototoday and the Pica service, all participants will be able to receive their photos directly to their smartphones, immediately after the race and with full respect for privacy. The photos will be immediately available, once you log in to the app (or [getpica.com](http://getpica.com)) and enter the code on your bib, and you will be able to see them right away and they will be ready for purchase. If you have lost your bib and want the Pica code write to [info@phototoday.it](mailto:info@phototoday.it) or [support@getpica.freshdesk.com](mailto:support@getpica.freshdesk.com) indicating your bib number and race name.

## NON-PARTICIPATION AND REFUND OF REGISTRATION FEES

The entry fee is non-refundable. Athletes who are unable to participate in the race for any reason will be offered two options, which must be communicated to the organizers:

- transfer their registration to the 2027 TORINO CITY MARATHON upon payment of an additional €15.00 administrative fee by September 30, 2026; after that date, the fee will be €25.00.

Requests, accompanied by a receipt for payment of the administrative fee and sent in writing to the e-mail address [trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it](mailto:trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it), must be received no later than December 15, 2026. The secretariat will confirm receipt in

the weeks following the conclusion of the event. Upon acceptance of the request, a code will be sent to allow you to register independently on the Endu.net portal (the code must be entered in the first step, regarding the selection of race type and amount, in the box "Discount code?").

- Transferring registration to another person FOR THE SAME EDITION OF THE EVENT upon payment of an administrative fee:
  - € 15 until 30<sup>th</sup> September 2026;
  - € 25 from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 20<sup>h</sup> November 2026;
  - € 35 from 21<sup>st</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026;

Any athlete who withdraws from the race to allow another athlete to take their place must notify the organizers by sending an e-mail to: [trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it](mailto:trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it). Once the request has been received and accepted, the organization will send a code to the same e-mail address, which the transferring athlete can share with the new participant for use on the Endu.net platform (the code must be entered in the first step, regarding the selection of race type and amount, in the "Do you have a discount code?" box).

Each of the above options may be used only once. Transfers cannot be combined with any other discounts.

**ROUTE CHANGES - SUSPENSION, POSTPONEMENT AND/OR CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT**

# TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON

If the race is cancelled, moved to another date and/or, in any case, not held due to causes not dependent and/or not attributable to the will of the Organizers, including the revocation of the authorization to hold the race by the competent Public Bodies, for any reason whatsoever, the registered participant shall have nothing to claim from Team Marathon S.S.D.r.l. or other co-organizers, not even by way of reimbursement of expenses incurred and mere registration for the race.

Waiver of any claim for damages and/or compensation and/or any claim for reinstatement and/or satisfaction of any pecuniary loss suffered.

---

## COMPLAINTS

Complaints regarding the result or conduct of a race must be submitted within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the race result to the Race Referee. The Competition Organizing Committee is required to ensure that the time of announcement of all results is recorded.

RTI 8.7 - A complaint to the Appeal Jury must be made, in writing, within 30 minutes:

8.7.1 - from the official announcement of the corrected result from the decision made by the Referee;

8.7.2 - from the negative response given to those who filed the complaint, when there is no change in the result.

It must be in writing, signed by the athlete, someone acting on his/her behalf, or an official representative of the team, and must be accompanied by a deposit of USD 100 or equivalent, which will be retained if the complaint is not accepted.

## FRAUDULENT PARTICIPATION IN THE RACE - PENALTIES

The registered participant is responsible for the ownership and safekeeping of his or her race bib, acquiring the right to use all services mentioned in these regulations and subsequently communicated.

- Anyone who, without regular registration, participates without a bib, in addition to being held responsible for damage to persons or property, including himself, will incur sports sanctions under the jurisdiction of the federal bodies and may be liable to the criminal penalties provided for the crime of "theft" (art. 624. c.p.).

- Anyone who, without proper registration, participates with a counterfeit bib or otherwise not in accordance with the allocation, in addition to being liable as indicated above, will incur the sports sanctions and, in addition, may be liable to the criminal penalties provided for the crime of "theft" (art. 624. c.p.), or, alternatively, for the crime of "fraud" (art. 640 c.p.).

In cases (a) and (b), participants may be liable for the penalties provided for the crime of "failure to comply with the measures of the Authorities" (Art. 650 of the Criminal Code). The aforementioned cases will be found only upon verification of photographic and/or video documentation.

- "OVERALL" prizes may be combined with "OVERALL ITALIAN MEN'S AND WOMEN'S" prizes;
- Category prizes may not be combined with other prizes (OVERALL and OVERALL ITALIAN MEN'S AND WOMEN'S);
- Category prizes will be paid at the end of the event;
- "OVERALL" and "OVERALL ITALIAN MEN - WOMEN" prizes will be paid via bank transfer within 90 days;
- Prizes for LARGE CLUBS will be paid exclusively at the end of the event to a designated club representative only.

# TORINO CITY HALF MARATHON



The distribution of cash prizes is carried out in accordance with World Athletics rules and the laws of the Italian State.

The prize pool reserved for Italian athletes and “equivalent Italians” (equal to 25% of the total prize pool), awarded based on ranking position, is cumulative with the general prize pool.

No cash prizes (or similar benefits: general gift certificates, bonuses, appearance fees, or expense reimbursements of any kind and for any reason) may be awarded to holders of “Runcard” and “Runcard EPS” cards.

The prize pool dedicated to Italian athletes will not be awarded for men’s times exceeding 1h11’00 or women’s times exceeding 1h23’00.
