## TORINO CITY MARATHON La maratona di Torino - 29/11/2026

### RULES

**Team Marathon Società Sportiva Dilettantistica a responsabilità limitata**, affiliated with the Federazione Italiana di Atletica Leggera (FIDAL) with code TO271 in collaboration with the **Fondazione Piemontese per la Ricerca sul Cancro** (hereinafter jointly "the Organising Committee"), with the approval of FIDAL is organising the 37th edition of the Maratona di Torino, officially named "Torino City Marathon", an event included in the international road running calendar over the distance of 42.195 km.

### ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATIONS

By registering for the TORINO CITY MARATHON, the athlete declares to know in its entirety and unconditionally accept these regulations as well as to be aware that participating in the TORINO CITY MARATHON and/or sporting events in general is potentially a risky activity. The athlete also declares that he/she assumes all the risks deriving from his/her participation in the event: falls, contact with vehicles, with other participants, spectators or others, weather conditions, traffic and road conditions, any kind of risk well known and assessed. By submitting the online registration form the athlete relieves and releases the organisers of all present and future claims or liability of any kind, as well as for damage to persons and/or property, known or unknown, resulting from his/her participation in the event, not attributable to the organising committee.

Participation in the races implies the unreserved acceptance of these regulations in all their parts by registered participants. Participants are also obliged to comply with the Highway Code after the time limit has been exceeded. By registering, each participant undertakes to comply with these regulations and releases the organisers from any civil or criminal liability for any accident or incident, for damage to persons or property caused to him or by him, which may occur during the event, not attributable to the organiser.

**IMPORTANT NOTE:** By registering for the TORINO CITY MARATHON, each athlete declares under his/her own responsibility that he/she has verified that his/her FIDAL - RUNCARD STANDARD OR EPS - WORLD ATHLETICS (Ex IAAF) licence and MEDICAL CERTIFICATE FOR LIGHT ATHLETICS - HEALTH FORM are valid on the date of the event. In the event that the requirements are not verified

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by the athlete or the club to which the subscriber belongs, the subscriber undertakes to update them, or have them updated, by the date of the event. No reimbursement will be issued by the organiser if the subscriber fails to meet the above specifications.

By registering for the TORINO CITY MARATHON, the participant declares that he/she is not aware of any previous medical condition or injury which may put him/her at risk during the event.

The athlete also self-certifies the non-existence of sporting, civil and/or criminal sanctions for doping, and declares that he/she has not taken - and does not take - substances included in the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA) anti-doping list. It is recalled that, in accordance with the federal regulations in force, competitors may be subject to anti-doping controls by the competent authorities.

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## COMPLIANCE WITH HEALTH PROTECTION REGULATIONS

Every participant enrolled in the TORINO CITY MARATHON undertakes, at the time of enrolment, to comply with the health protection regulations (ordinary and/or extraordinary) in force on the date of the event, including the provisions issued through specific Decreti-Legge (D.L.) and/or Decrees of the President of the Council of Ministers (D.P.C.M.).

## PARTICIPATION RULES

With reference to the provisions of the Rules for the Organisation of Events (art. 34) issued by the Italian Athletics Federation, all athletes aged 20 years and over (one thousandth of age) who belong to one of the following categories may take part in the event

### 1 - ITALIAN AND FOREIGN ATHLETES RESIDENT IN ITALY (competitive section)

- MEMBERS OF COMPANIES (S.S.D./A.S.D.) affiliated with FIDAL for the 2026 sports season, belonging to the Promesse (20-22 years old) and Seniores (23-34 years old), Master (SM/SF35, SM/SF40, SM/SF45, SM/SF50, SM/SF55, SM60/SF60 and over, SM70 and over) categories, in possession of a valid medical certificate for ATLETICA LEGGERA on the date of the event;
- Members of a club (S.S.D./A.S.D.) affiliated with a sports promotion body (EPS) affiliated with FIDAL for the 2026 sports season (athletics discipline) or individual members (the membership card is issued directly by the relevant EPS committee), who are in possession of the RUNCARD EPS ([www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com)) and the AGONISTICO medical certificate for LIGHT ATHLETICS valid on the date of the event (the certificate must be uploaded online on the registration form, or delivered to the Organising Committee no later than 10 days before the date of the competition);
- NON-MEMBERS for companies (S.S.D./A.S.D.) affiliated with FIDAL or a FIDAL-approved Sports Promotion Body for the 2026 sports season, who are in possession of a STANDARD RUNCARD ([www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com)) and a valid AGONISTICA medical certificate for LIGHT ATHLETICS on the date of the event (the certificate must be uploaded online on the registration form, or delivered to the Organising Committee no later than 10 days before the date of the competition);

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## 2 - ITALIAN AND FOREIGN ATHLETES AND ATHLETES NOT RESIDENT IN ITALY (competitive section)

- Registered members of foreign Athletics Clubs and Federations, affiliated to WORLD ATHLETICS (ex. IAAF) for the 2026 sports season, belonging to the Promesse (20-22 years old) and Seniores (23-34 years old), Master (SM/SF35, SM/SF40, SM/SF45, SM/SF50, SM/SF55, SM60/SF60 and over, SM70 and over) categories.

N.B. Non-EU athletes must have a residence permit or be in possession of an entry visa.

- ITALIAN CITIZENS residing abroad who are not members of any foreign athletics clubs or federations affiliated with WORLD ATHLETICS (formerly IAAF), and who meet the following requirements:
  - A STANDARD RUNCARD valid on the date of the event (which can be obtained from the website [www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com));
  - a medical certificate of fitness for competitive athletics, valid on the date of the event (the certificate must be uploaded online via the registration form, or submitted to the Organising Committee no later than 10 days before the competition takes place);
- FOREIGN NATIONALS, resident abroad, not registered with foreign athletics clubs or federations affiliated to WORLD ATHLETICS (formerly IAAF), must meet the following requirements:
  - A valid STANDARD RUNCARD on the date of the event (available to sign up on the website [www.runcard.com](http://www.runcard.com));
  - MEDICAL CERTIFICATE of fitness for competitive ATHLETICS, valid on the date of the event (the certificate must be completed by a doctor in the athlete's country of residence and uploaded online via the registration form, or submitted to the Organising Committee no later than 10 days before the date of the competition);

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE: the medical certificate must meet all the requirements set by the Italian Athletics Federation.

## 3 - RUNNERS FOR TOURIST SPORTING GOALS

From 2019, following the Federal resolution, RUNNER FOR TOURIST SPORTING GOALS registration has been allowed exclusively for foreign citizens, non-members, resident abroad who come to Italy for tourist-sporting reasons.

For this type of participant, they will start in the grids set up for the competitive race, according to the time declared during registration, wearing dedicated identification bibs, but they will not be included in the official classifications and will not participate in the prize money (whether it consists of prizes in kind or money).

When collecting the bib number, participants must present a copy of their identity document/passport and hand in the Liability Waiver Form, which can be downloaded from the following link: [CLICK HERE](#)

## IMPORTANT NOTE FOR TRIATHLETES

TRIATHLETES can only and exclusively participate with FIDAL RUNCARD STANDARD or RUNCARD EPS.

We would like to remind you that the competitive medical certificate valid on the date of the event must state the discipline "ATLETICA LEGGERA OR ATHLETIC".

A competitive medical certificate for the sole discipline of "TRIATHLON" will not be considered valid because it is exclusively related to the Italian Triathlon Federation.

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## PARTICIPATION OF ATHLETES IN THE ELITE CATEGORY

With reference to rule 1 of the RTI, ELITE athletes are considered to be male participants whose bib numbering falls between No. 1 and No. 100 and female participants whose bib numbering falls between No. 101 and No. 130 (inclusive).

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## REGISTRATION FEES

- Free registration for disabled people in the wheelchair category registered with C.I.P. - FISPE members (by 1<sup>st</sup> November 2026);
- €45 – promotional rate valid until 31<sup>st</sup> March 2026;
- €55 – from 1<sup>st</sup> April to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2026;
- €65 – from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> September 2026;
- €75 – from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 31<sup>st</sup> October 2026;
- €100 – from 1<sup>st</sup> November to 20<sup>th</sup> November 2026;
- €120 – on November 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup> at the Torino City Marathon Village;
- €150 – from 7:00 to 8:00 a.m., at a designated area near the start (only in exceptional cases).

N.B. Registration for the Torino City Marathon will be suspended from 21<sup>st</sup> November to 26<sup>th</sup> November and will resume at the Torino City Marathon Village on 27<sup>th</sup> November from 10:00 a.m. until 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026, at 8:00 p.m.

## REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT METHODS

- Online at Endu.net (until 23:59 on 20<sup>th</sup> November 2026) - payment by credit cards (except AMEX circuit), direct bank transfer;

NB: Registration using the latter method involves additional fees.

- At the Torino City Marathon Village on the following days and times (payment by cash, pos or satispay);
  - Friday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2026, from 10.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.;
  - Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026, from 10.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m.;
- In a designated zone near the start area:
  - Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> November 2026, from 7:00 a.m. to 8.00 a.m.

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## CONFIRMATION OF REGISTRATION

You will be able to check the status of your registration by following the instructions provided on [www.torinocitymarathon.it](http://www.torinocitymarathon.it). The allocation of bib numbers will take

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place close to the race: a few days before the race, all duly registered athletes will receive an e-mail communication valid as an official 'confirmation letter'. This e-mail will contain all the basic instructions for collecting the bib number and participating in the race. It is not necessary to print out a hard copy of the e-mail itself; it will be possible to present it on a device such as a smartphone or tablet.

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## BIB DISTRIBUTION AND TECHNICAL GADGETS

Bibs will be distributed at the Torino City Marathon Village on the following days and times:

- Friday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2026, from 10.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m;
- Saturday 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026, from 10.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m

Documents required for bib collection:

### ITALIAN ATHLETES

- FIDAL card (paper/digital coupon issued by your club) or FIDAL RUNCARD STANDARD or EPS card;
- For STANDARD RUNCARD or EPS holders, copy of the MEDICAL CERTIFICATE FOR AGONISTIC ATHLETES for ATLETICA LEGGERA (in the event that a colour copy was not provided during registration);
- Identity document or proxy for collection or copy of payment.

### FOREIGN ATHLETES

- Card issued by the foreign Athletics Federation to which they belong or FIDAL RUNCARD STANDARD;
- For holders of RUNCARD STANDARD a copy of the HEALTH FORM (if no copy was provided during registration);
- Identity document or proxy for collection or copy of payment.

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## BAG SERVICE

Participants will be able to hand in their bags with their clothing at the designated area in the finish area, and collect them from the same area once the race is over. The organisation declines all responsibility for any loss of valuables and/or money.

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## REFRESHMENT

Refreshment points will be present every 5 km:

- Refreshments at the 5th and 10 km – Water;
  - Refreshments at the 15 Km, 20 Km, 25 Km, 30 Km, 35 Km, 40 Km - Water, Supplements and solid food.
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## CUSTOMISED REFRESHMENTS

Participants will be able to take advantage of personalised refreshments. On Sunday 29<sup>th</sup> November, a vehicle will be stationed in the start area until 8:00 a.m. By that time, it will be possible to deposit one's personalised refreshment in the baskets corresponding to the Km where one wishes to take advantage of it.

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## TIMING

The race will be timed by EvoData and official and real times will be recorded.

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## RANKINGS

All competitors will receive the chip, already pre-positioned on the bib. Four time controls will be positioned, respectively at the 10 km and at the 21.097 km, plus a surprise one (useful for detecting "cuts" on the route), and the following classifications will be drawn up

- General arrival order calculated on the basis of the official time.
  - GENERAL ranking;
  - CATEGORY rankings;
  - ASD/SSD rankings (by to the numbers of arrivals).
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## OFFICIAL PRIZE-GIVING CEREMONY

The official prize-giving will start at 11:30 a.m.; the first five women and the first five men of the GENERAL ranking, the first five women and the first five ITALIAN men of the GENERAL ranking will be awarded on stage. All other classified and

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numerous companies will be able to view the rankings published in real time on Endu.net and go to the stand next to the stage to collect their prize directly.

Please note: unclaimed prizes will not be sent home and no notification, written or verbal, will be given to winners about their non-collection. Category prizes not collected during the prize-giving ceremony of the event will no longer be delivered.

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## PACER SERVICE

Pacemakers will be available to the athletes and recognisable by a bib and a personalised balloon on which their respective times will be indicated.

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## MEDAL AND PARTICIPATION DIPLOMA

All finishers will receive at the finish line the TORINO CITY MARATHON participation medal and can print their official participation diploma on Endu.net

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## PHOTO SERVICE

With Phototoday and the Pica service, all participants will be able to receive their photos directly on their smartphones, immediately after the race and in full respect for their privacy. The photos are already available, once you log in to the app (or getpica.com) and enter the code on your bib, you will be able to see them immediately and they will be ready for purchase.

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## NON-PARTICIPATION AND REFUND OF REGISTRATION FEES

The entry fee is non-refundable. Athletes who are unable to participate in the race for any reason will be offered two options, which must be communicated to the organizers:

- transfer their registration to the 2027 TORINO CITY MARATHON upon payment of an additional €15.00 administrative fee by September 30, 2026; after that date, the fee will be €25.00.

Requests, accompanied by a receipt for payment of the administrative fee and sent in writing to the e-mail address [trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it](mailto:trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it), must be received no later than December 15, 2026. The secretariat will confirm receipt in the weeks following the conclusion of the event. Upon acceptance of the request, a code will be sent to allow you to register independently on the Endu.net portal (the code must be entered in the first step, regarding the selection of race type and amount, in the box "Discount code?").

- Transferring registration to another person FOR THE SAME EDITION OF THE EVENT upon payment of an administrative fee:

- € 15 until 30<sup>th</sup> September 2026;
- € 25 from 1<sup>st</sup> October to 20<sup>th</sup> November 2026;
- € 35 from 21<sup>st</sup> to 28<sup>th</sup> November 2026;

Any athlete who withdraws from the race to allow another athlete to take their place must notify the organizers by sending an e-mail to: [trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it](mailto:trasferimenti@torinocitymarathon.it). Once the request has been received and accepted, the organization will send a code to the same e-mail address, which the transferring athlete can share with the new participant for use on the Endu.net platform (the code must be entered in the first step, regarding the selection of race type and amount, in the "Do you have a discount code?" box).

Each of the above options may be used only once. Transfers cannot be combined with any other discounts.

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## CHANGES TO THE ROUTE - SUSPENSION, POSTPONEMENT AND/OR CANCELLATION OF THE EVENT

Should the race be cancelled, postponed to another date and/or, in any case, not carried out due to causes that do not depend on and/or cannot be attributed to the will of the Organisers, including the revocation of the authorisation to hold the race by the competent Public Bodies, for any reason whatsoever, the participant will have nothing to claim from Team Marathon S.S.D.r.l. or other co-organisers, not even by way of reimbursement of expenses incurred and mere registration to the race.

It renounces any claim for damages and/or compensation and/or any claim for reinstatement and/or satisfaction of any pecuniary loss suffered.

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## COMPLAINTS

Complaints concerning the result or conduct of a race must be lodged within 30 minutes of the official announcement of the race result with the Race Referee. The Organising Committee of the competition is required to ensure that the time of the announcement of all results is recorded.

- RTI 8.7 - A complaint to the Appeal Jury must be made, in writing, within 30 minutes;
- 8.7.1 - from the official announcement of the corrected result from the decision made by the Referee;
- 8.7.2 - from the negative response given to the claimant, when there is no change in the result.

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It must be in writing, signed by the athlete, someone acting on his/her behalf or an official representative of the team and must be accompanied by a deposit of USD 100 or equivalent, which will be retained if the complaint is not accepted.

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## FRAUDULENT PARTICIPATION IN THE COMPETITION - SANCTIONS

The registered participant is responsible for the ownership and custody of his race bib and acquires the right to use all the services mentioned in these regulations and subsequently communicated.

- Anyone who, without regular registration, takes part without a race bib, in addition to being held liable for damage to persons or property, including himself, will incur sporting sanctions under the jurisdiction of the federal bodies and may be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the offence of "theft" (art. 624. penal code).
- Anyone who, without regular registration, takes part with a forged or otherwise non-compliant bib number, as well as being liable as indicated above, will incur sporting penalties and may also be liable to the criminal sanctions provided for the offence of "theft" (art. 624. criminal code), or, alternatively, the offence of "fraud" (art. 640. criminal code).

In cases a) and b), participants may be liable for the penalties provided for the offence of "failure to comply with the provisions of the Authorities" (Article 650 of the Criminal Code). The aforementioned cases will only be found after verification of photographic and/or video documentation.

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- The OVERALL prizes can be combined with the OVERALL ITALIAN - ITALIAN prizes;
- Categories prizes cannot be combined with other prizes (OVERALL and OVERALL ITALIAN - ITALIAN);
- Category prizes will be paid at the end of the event;
- The "OVERALL" and "OVERALL ITALIAN - ITALIAN" prizes will be paid by B.B. within 90 days;
- The prizes of the NUMEROUS COMPANIES (min. 15 entrants) will only be paid out at the end of the event to a company manager.

Prize money will be paid out in accordance with World Athletics rules and the laws of the Italian state.

The prize money reserved for Italian athletes and "Italians treated as equals" (equal to 25% of the prize money), which is awarded per ranking position, can be combined with the general prize money.

No cash prizes (or similar: generic value vouchers, bonuses, engagements, reimbursement of expenses of any kind and for any reason whatsoever) may be envisaged for 'Runcard' and 'Runcard EPS' holders.

The prize money for Italians will not be awarded for men's chronometric performances over 2h30'00 and women's over 2h55'00.
