Six **Designations** of Scripture

(The names God gives His Word — each revealing a different facet of the same divine speech)

- **Law**
 - **Testimony**
 - **Precepts**
 - **Commandment**
 - **Fear**
 - **Rules**

Six **Descriptions** of Scripture

(What God's Word is like — objective qualities, not emotional responses)

- **Perfect**
 - **Sure**
 - **Right**
 - **Pure**
 - **Clean**
 - **True**

Six **Deliverances** of Scripture

(What God's Word accomplishes in those who receive it)

- **Revives the Soul**
 - **Makes Wise the Simple**
 - **Rejoices the Heart**
 - **Enlightens the Eyes**

- **Endures Forever**
 - **Righteous Altogether**

1. **Inerrancy** — God's Word Is True Without Error

Application — Living Under the Voice of God

1. **Look Up** at God's World (*Observe and acknowledge — Psalm 19:1–6*)

2. **Look At** and **Look To** God's Word (*Read and trust — Psalm 19:7*)

3. **Learn** God's Word (*Read, study, write, and speak — Psalm 19:7–8*)

Learning God's Word involves:

- **Reading** it regularly
- **Studying** it carefully
- **Writing** it into our hearts
- **Speaking** it into the lives of others

4. **Listen** to God's Word (*Read and hear — Psalm 19:8–9*)

5. **Love** God's Word (*Read and obey — Psalm 19:8–10*)

6. **Live** God's Word (*Read and apply — Psalm 19:11–14*)
