Notes From the Vestry

Due to the impending storm and its timing, we are cancelling services this Sunday for the sake of safety. We look forward to seeing you next Sunday.

The food ministry bag packing, previously scheduled for next Tuesday, will be held tomorrow to avoid complications from the storm. We will update the website homepage with any weather related closings next week.

As Carrie mentioned at the Annual Meeting, the existing lighting in the sanctuary has been in place for well over 70 years. We have been working with a lighting firm and electrical contractor to help us upgrade the lighting and replace everything with LED fixtures. The proposed lanterns will look similar to what we currently have in place. We will also be replacing the current dimmer panel and hope to have the electrical work completed by the Spring. We have received the proposal outlining the scope of the work and the cost for completing this project. Once we have further clarification on a couple of questions, the proposal will be brought to the vestry for final approval.

Lent is fast approaching and there are many activities coming up in the next two months as we journey toward Easter. The first one to mark on your calendar is for Tuesday, February 17th from 5-7 PM as we have our Shrove Tuesday Church Supper. This year, Rich Meyer will also be providing gumbo as part of the celebration. We look forward to seeing everyone for an evening of great food and fellowship!

We are in the process of planning an Adult Forum for late February or early March with the director of the Cremation Society of Virginia. We have had interest shown in providing information on this topic as well as our columbarium.

We invite everyone to “come and see” what is happening at Trinity as we move forward in our search for a new rector.

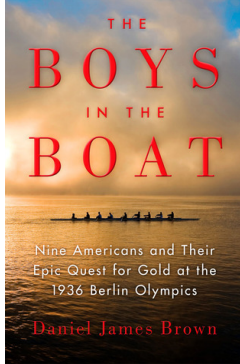

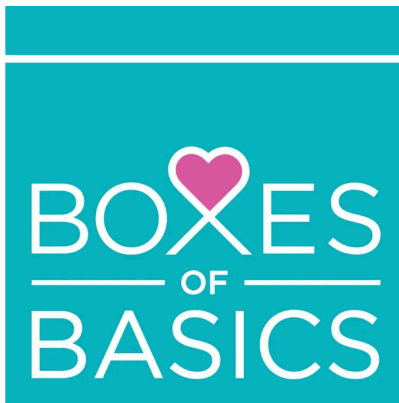

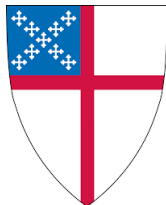
