Notes From the Vestry

We are awaiting a second opinion from a structural engineer to determine the best way to address the bell tower issues. It is our hope to have that information within the next week and have repairs completed by the end of the summer. The replacement doors for the office entrance off the parking lot will take five to seven weeks to manufacture and then installation will be scheduled. The lighting contractor is working on scheduling the new sanctuary lighting after VBS. Last but not least, relief is coming for Margaret in the battle of the cable loving mice. Orkin has been by and are setting traps on the outside by the vents and showing us where we need to install screens to prevent them from reentering the building. A trap will also be placed in the cellar where they have obviously been enjoying the catacomb like atmosphere as they dined on organ cable wires.

Trinity is once again participating in the school supplies drive for our friends in the Georgetown South community. For the past several years we have collected everything from backpacks to pencils to help students begin a new school year with the appropriate supplies every child needs. You will find a yellow school bus in the Narthex along with fliers and QR codes with links to this project. Additional details are available in this week's newsletter. We will be collecting supplies through August 3rd. Meg Carroll, an incredible leader in GTS, is setting up a store in the community center so kids can come in and pick out their own school supplies. This gesture means so much and allows kids to experience what so many others take for granted. I have spoken to Meg several times throughout the year, and the gratitude from her and the staff regarding our assistance with the Food Ministry, Christmas, and supplies is so heartfelt. We are a steady, nonintrusive presence in a community that is dealing with so many things at this time. We are hoping to increase our presence in GTS this fall as part of a tutoring program that was discontinued due to unforeseen circumstances last year, but is being discussed for the coming school year. As information becomes available, we will let you know of opportunities to serve.

We continue to have Jim + , Philene + , and Larry + lead us in worship and they will continue their service until our vacancy is filled. It is a wonderful blessing that these three people have been with us from the beginning of our journey and will continue to walk the way with us. Their constant faith, leadership, and love of our parish is a gift from God and we are most grateful for their presence in our lives.

Please join us this Sunday either in person or on Livestream as we gather together as a family and receive God's gift of grace and peace to see us through another week.

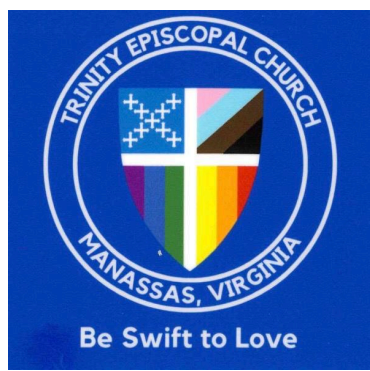

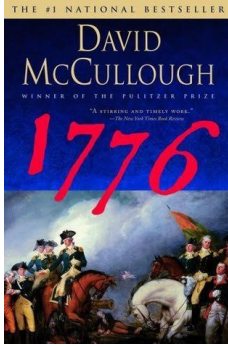

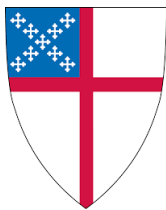
