Notes From the Vestry

Roof repairs and foundation work will begin in July and should be completed sometime in August. There should be minimal disruption to activities during this time. We have our plumber coming out to inspect the sump pump in the cellar. We want to make sure that the recent issue with it shutting off and water pooling on the floor is addressed. This pump is old and it would not be a surprise if it needs replaced.

Moving on to more pleasant topics, VBS is just around the corner from July 20-24. We are excited about the curriculum and activities that will be offered to our children. Many opportunities are available to assist with this fun project. A final planning meeting is scheduled this Sunday, June 28th, after the 11:00 service in the parish hall. Everyone interested in helping is encouraged to attend. Sign your child up and have them bring a friend. A picnic is planned for the last day.

Please continue to hold the Discernment Team in your prayers. They are doing a wonderful job in working through a time-intensive process that will eventually lead to our calling a new rector to walk our journey with us. If the process seems to be taking longer than usual, it is! Our situation warranted some changes prior to the diocese giving approval to begin a search. Cindy Barnes has been instrumental in helping us meet that goal. For the past two years, she has worked first with the vestry, and then the congregation, as we clarified our mission, healed our spirit, and reclaimed who we are as God's people. The Discernment Team has taken all the information gathered throughout the past year and is using that to fulfill their mission of finding a new rector to join us on this exciting journey we are so boldly walking. The vestry is grateful to have such an incredible team leading this search.

There are many challenges that face us every day. Human nature has a tendency to make us doubt ourselves or our decisions. We have all been in that situation. As a parish, we are not immune from those same feelings. When God's time does not align with ours, it is easy to think we should be doing something different or could have done something better. When God reveals the plans He has for us, it is then easy to see why things unfolded the way God intended. We await God's plan for us and we take a deep breath knowing that at the right time, the Holy Spirit will lead us to where God wants us to be. Trinity is alive and joyful and doing our best to love one another as Jesus commanded us to do. What a blessing to share this with so many in our parish family and community!

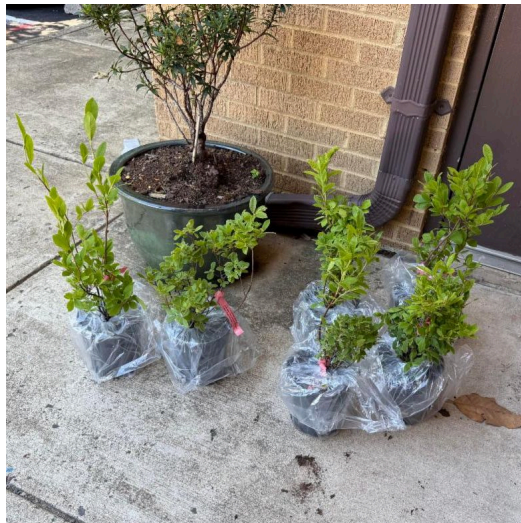
For this week, we have a more recent entry. Who knows the identity of this Santa?

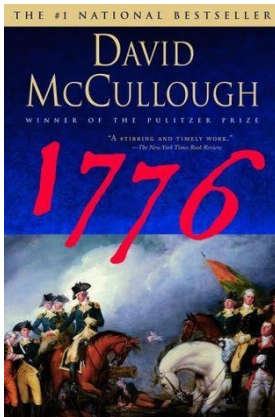

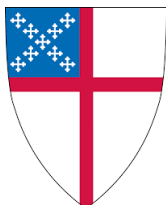
