Notes From the Vestry

This has been a relatively quiet week at Trinity and there is not much to report from the Vestry. We are waiting for a roofing company to come out next week and inspect the roof and let us know what may need repaired. We have had some minor issues over the past several months and want to make sure nothing major is lurking underneath the membrane. JES, the foundation company that has assisted us in the past, is coming to inspect foundation concerns that we have downstairs. Several issues were pointed out by our plumbing company when they were addressing other problems a few weeks ago and we felt it was prudent to contact JES. We need to see what repairs may be required to address erosion issues caused by some type of water problem in the basement. Once we have all the information, the Vestry will determine what course of action we need to take. Whether it's our own homes, or Trinity, problems need to be addressed as they arise. We know how expensive it can get when maintenance is deferred.

In the meantime, we are looking forward to VBS the week of July 20-24 and the church picnic on August 30th following one unified service at 11:00 AM. Samantha and I are using this time to catch up on things that took a back seat to more pressing issues during the year. It is also nice to have some time to make sure everything is in place whenever we call a new rector.

Beginning this Sunday, Father Jim is leading Adult Forum at 9:45 AM on the Book of Job. Come and enjoy an interesting perspective on Job and his faith through trying times.

We welcome everyone to join us this coming Sunday either on Livestream or in person. May you have a blessed week and rejoice knowing you are part of an awesome parish family!

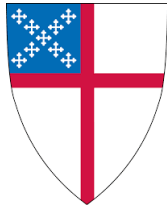
