



If you've been in or around the motorcycle industry for any length of time, the name RC Components isn't new to you. When the boss called and told me RC was interested in becoming part of the URM – SB family, I was excited to have another reputable brand in our lineup. I knew the company from both the consumer side, and as a shop owner for many years. So, when the opportunity presented itself to take a tour of the facility I couldn't grab the camera gear fast enough.



Being in the Urban Rides – Street Bagger family is more than just advertising & promotion; we strive to facilitate brand growth any way we can. Another new advertiser we work with, Nash Customs, had mentioned a desire to offer custom-branded parts to their clientele. Shortly after hearing



that, I was on the phone with RC's Director of Sales & Marketing, RJ Clutter. He said, we absolutely can help them out with that! What better way to introduce Nash to RC than a company tour? The head honcho of Nash, Craig Collins, came along and the visit doubled as a business meeting for the brands. We love making those kinds of introductions when we know it's a win-win for both members of the URM – SB family!

Craig and I hopped in the shop truck and rolled an hour north to Bowling Green to see what the RC Components operation was all about, and it's impressive.

Entering the building you're met with a reception area that shows the history of the company. The timeline wall really gives a perspective on how far the owner and President, Rick Ball, has come since the late eighties. To think it all started with wanting some lightweight billet wheels for his bike build. After working with the infamous Boyd Coddington on the first wheels, Rick began production with one CNC machine in a garage in Southern California. In 1993 RC Components moved operations to Bowling Green, KY and unveiled the first RC street wheel at the Dealer Expo in the

same year. From there it was all throttle to where the company is today. The solid foundation which built the company created a platform to continuously innovate and offer more products to both the motorcycle

and auto industry.




After attending the business meeting between RJ and Craig, we got an in depth look at what production looks like in the massive facility. Walking through the transition from office

area to production floor was the thought, "Goodness, this is a big operation." Of course we can't show you everything, RC Components didn't sign up for us to spill all their secrets. I will say though, the stuff RJ said

times I was trying to get some good camera angles while RJ & Craig were walking through, I look up...where's everyone at? Immediately I felt like a toddler in the grocery store that lost my mom or dad. I'm now a big oaf waving a camera, dipping my head down walkways hoping to see where they went. Thankfully I didn't need to set up camp under a pile of chrome wheels and exhaust pipes until a search party went out.
