**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:  
The Feast of Corpus Christi**

There is a story told in many parishes of a dying man who had not been to church in years. When the priest arrived with Holy Communion, the man's eyes filled with tears. He struggled to sit up, folded his hands, and whispered, "I have waited so long for Him." In that quiet room, all the noise of life seemed to fade away. There was no wealth, no success, no accomplishment that mattered in that moment—only Jesus, truly present in the Eucharist. That scene captures the heart of the Feast of Corpus Christi. On this beautiful solemnity, the Church invites us not only to remember a doctrine, but to adore a Person: Christ Himself, who gives us His Body and Blood as the food of eternal life.

The Feast of Corpus Christi, whose Latin name means "the Body of Christ," arose in the thirteenth century out of a deepening love for the Eucharist. Its origins are closely linked to **St. Juliana of Liège**, who longed for a special feast dedicated to the Blessed Sacrament. In 1264, **Pope Urban IV** extended the celebration to the universal Church, and **St. Thomas Aquinas** composed many of its beautiful prayers and hymns, including *Pange Lingua* and *Tantum Ergo*. From the beginning, this feast was meant to strengthen faith in the Real Presence of Jesus and to draw the faithful into deeper reverence, gratitude, and joy before so great a gift.

This year's Scripture readings lead us directly into the mystery we celebrate. In 1 Corinthians 10:16-17, St. Paul reminds us that "the cup of blessing that we bless" is a participation in the Blood of Christ, and "the bread that we break" is a participation in the Body of Christ. Because there is one bread, we who are many are one body. In John 6:51-58, Jesus speaks with unmistakable clarity: "I am the living bread that came down from heaven," and **"whoever eats this bread will live forever."** Corpus Chris-

ti is therefore not only a feast of adoration, but also of communion. The Eucharist unites us to Christ and binds us to one another as His Body in the world.

Across the world, Catholics celebrate Corpus Christi with striking beauty and public witness. In Italy, Spain, and Portugal, city streets are often lined with flowers, banners, and decorated altars as the Blessed Sacrament is carried through towns and neighborhoods. In Poland, entire communities gather for outdoor processions, with children scattering petals before the Eucharistic Lord. In parts of Latin America and Brazil, the faithful create colorful carpets from flowers, sawdust, and natural materials, transforming ordinary streets into pathways of devotion. These customs differ from country to country, yet they all proclaim the same truth: Jesus does not remain distant from His people but walks among them.

One of the most beloved traditions of this feast is the Corpus Christi procession. After Mass, the Blessed Sacrament is placed in the monstrance and carried solemnly among the faithful. This procession is not merely a custom; it is a public profession of faith in the Real Presence of Christ. It tells the world that Jesus is at the center of our parish, our homes, and our lives. For those who participate with devotion, the procession brings many spiritual benefits. It deepens love for the Eucharist, strengthens Catholic identity, encourages reverence, and unites the parish in prayer and witness. The Church has long cherished such participation as a source of grace, inviting us to walk with Christ and to let Him bless our streets, our families, and our community.

Another cherished tradition on Corpus Christi is the creation of a floral carpet. These beautiful and often intricate designs are made only to last for a short time, yet their very simplicity reveals something profound: when love is offered to the Lord, nothing is wasted. The floral carpet becomes an act of praise, sacrifice, and communal devotion, prepared so that the Eucharistic Lord may pass over a pathway made with care and love. In that spirit, we offer heartfelt thanks to our Filipino Community and to the Legion of Mary for the creation of this year's Floral Carpet. Their generosity, artistry, and devotion help all of us enter more deeply into the beauty of this solemn feast.

Corpus Christi also challenges us to make the Eucharist more meaningful in our daily lives. We can do this by preparing well for Mass, arriving with recollection instead of rushing in distracted. We can spend a few quiet moments in thanksgiving after receiving Holy Communion. We can make visits to the Blessed Sacrament during the week, allowing our hearts to rest in the presence of the Lord. We can read and pray with the Sunday Scriptures ahead of time, especially passages like 1 Corinthians 10 and John 6, so that the Word prepares us to receive the Sacrament. Most important, we can let the Eucharist shape the way we live—becoming more forgiving, more humble, more generous, and more attentive to those in need. The One whom we receive at the altar sends us forth to become His presence in the world.

**On the Feast of Corpus Christi, we do not simply honor a sacred symbol; we adore the living Christ, who continues to feed His people with His own Body and Blood. In every Mass, heaven comes near. In every procession, the Church proclaims that Christ walks with His people. In every floral carpet, the faithful offer beauty to the One who is Beauty itself.** May this solemnity renew our wonder, strengthen our faith, and deepen our love for the Eucharist. And may all of us, nourished by the Bread of Life, become one body in Christ and joyful witnesses to His presence in the world.



### CONVALIDATION OF MARRIAGE



# It's Time to Register for September Religious Education Classes Grades K Through 8

### Religious Education Classes for Children

Catholic religious education programs, often referred to as CCD or PREP, aim to deepen children's understanding of the Catholic faith and prepare them for sacraments such as First Communion and Confirmation and to live out their Catholic faith. Our program includes classroom instruction, prayer, and liturgical celebrations, with a focus on scripture, doctrine, and living out one's faith. Parents play a vital role, with the Church assisting in their responsibility to nurture their child's faith.

#### **It is time to enroll your child in our Religious Education program for September!**

The registration form can be found on our website or in the church vestibule for your convenience. Please complete the registration form and return it to the religious education office or parish office as soon as possible. Information about the various class options we offer can be found on the church website under the Religious Education tab.

Please give us a call if you have any questions about our program, or if you have any questions about how to register. We're here to help!

We are always in need of catechists, substitute catechists and classroom assistants throughout the school year. ***If you have an hour or two to assist us, we would be most grateful for additional volunteers for our religious education program.***

### Sacramental Catch Up Program for Children

The Sacramental Catch-Up program is designed for families with children in grades 3 - 12 who have been baptized Catholic but have missed the usual window for receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. Through the Sacramental catch up program, we can assist your children to continue their faith formation and receive the sacraments appropriate for their age and stage of faith formation.

Over the course of the year, children and parents (at least one of the parents) will go through formation for First Eucharist, First Reconciliation, and/or Confirmation together to help the whole family prepare the child to receive the sacraments. Classes meet on alternate Sundays from 9:00 AM to 9:50AM in the St. Andrew's Parish Hall from September through May.

### Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

The OCIA distinguishes between several groups:

Catechumen: A non baptized person desiring all three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Candidate for Confirmation and Eucharist: A person already baptized either in the Catholic Church or a Christian denomination whose baptism is valid and desires to receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.
