From the Pastor's Desk



World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly – A Call to Faith, Hope, and Tenderness

Dear Parish Family, a few weeks ago, one of our parish teens noticed that his elderly neighbor, Mr. Leone, hadn't taken in his trash cans as usual. It was a small observation, but something didn't sit right. He knocked on the door,

waited, and when there was no answer, he told his parents—who called for help. Thankfully, Mr. Leone was okay, just recovering from an illness, but that moment became a turning point. What started as a small gesture led to regular visits, shared meals, and eventually, the teen adopted Mr. Leone as his adopted Grandfather. That teen may not have realized it then, but he embodied exactly what this weekend's Gospel invites us how to live: with **awareness, compassion, and faithful action**.

Today's Scripture readings are filled with spiritual richness. In **Luke 11:1–13**, Jesus teaches his disciples how to pray (the Lord's Prayer), urging them to ask, seek, and knock—assuring them (and us) of a Father who never withholds what is good. In the first reading, **Genesis 18:20–32**, we see Abraham interceding for others with boldness and mercy. And **Colossians 2:12–14** reminds us of the new life we have in Christ, a life that calls us beyond ourselves and into deeper communion with one another.

This spiritual foundation is especially meaningful this Sunday as we join the Church worldwide in celebrating the **World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly**, established by **Pope Francis in 2021** to honor those who hold the sacred task of preserving memory, passing on the faith, and offering enduring hope to younger generations.

This day is intentionally placed near the feast of **Saints Joachim and Anne**, the Grandparents of Jesus, to remind us that holiness often comes quietly through family stories, prayers, and lessons learned over time. The theme chosen for this year, *"Blessed are those who have not lost hope"* (Sirach 14:2), challenges all of us to see our elders not as forgotten voices, but as **living witnesses to God's faithfulness**.

In my opinion, it is not enough to honor our elders with

words alone—we are called to action. Here are some **practical ways to live out this message**:

For those with Grandparents or aging parents:

- **Spend quality time with them:** Put down the phone, turn off the TV, and truly engage.
- **Ask for their stories:** Our elders have lived through eras we only read about.
- **Pray with them:** Even simple prayer can be a powerful anchor.
- **Support their needs:** Whether it is a ride to appointments or help around the house, be present.

For elderly neighbors:

- **Introduce yourself:** A warm hello can crack the ice of isolation.
- **Offer assistance:** Trash cans, grocery runs, or just checking in, matters deeply.
- **Include them in community life:** Invite them to parish events or small group gatherings.
- **Be a prayer companion:** Let them know you are praying with and for them.

In our parish, we have a vibrant space dedicated to honoring and uplifting our elders. Our **Senior Ministry center**, affectionately known as **The Renaissance Center**, meets **every other week during the summer**, and then **twice a week after Labor Day**. It is a place filled with **fun, faith, laughter, and joy**—a true celebration of life.

I invite you to bring your Grandparents, elderly parents, or neighbors to experience the warmth and welcome of this ministry. Whether it is a bingo morning, a shared prayer, a bit of line dancing or chair exercises or a time for faith sharing or making some kind of craft, it is a time to enjoy a simple meal, coffee, dessert, and conversation. It is a chance to form meaningful bonds across generations. It is a special place for widows and widowers who tend to isolate themselves inside their homes.

There is no greater gift we can give our elders than our presence. And there is no clearer way to live the Gospel than by extending love to those who may feel invisible. Let us be a parish known for its kindness to those who

came before us. This week, I challenge each of you to **be like that teen**—to notice, to care, and to act. If you have Grandparents or aging parents, make time for them. If you have elderly neighbors, reach out. And if your heart is nudging you to do more, make an arrangement to bring them or provide transportation for them to come see what *The Renaissance Center* is all about.

Through our prayers and actions, may this World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly be more than a celebration—may it be a movement of compassion, dignity, and hope.


The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary: A Holy Day of Obligation

Joseph's House Monthly Casserole Recipe

Last month we collected 30 casseroles for Joseph's House. Thank you so much to our volunteers!!!! We are grateful for your dedication to this ministry. Along with casseroles, we will continue collecting individual snack bags for Joseph's House clients. The next drop off for casseroles will be Thursday, July 31, 2025 from 10-11AM. Drive up to the parish hall and a volunteer will be waiting for you in the parking lot. We will hand deliver to Joseph's House later in the day. If this day and time do not work for you, we can make other arrangements. Call or text Chris Parry at 856-906-5127 with any questions and/or to confirm you will make a casserole. Prepare one or more casseroles. All donations are greatly appreciated. We will continue to use the same recipe.

Hamburger Noodle Casserole

1 lb. hamburger
15 oz. can or jar tomato sauce
1 medium chopped onion
1 cup of green pepper

1 cup cottage cheese
1 cup sour cream
12oz. egg noodles
2 cups shredded Monterey Jack Cheese

Combine the hamburger, green pepper and onion and sauté until meat is cooked. Salt and pepper to taste.

Add tomato sauce and simmer for 20 minutes.

Cook noodles according to package directions.

In another bowl combine sour cream and cottage cheese.

Blend cottage cheese and sour cream mixture with the cooked noodles.

Salt and pepper to taste.

In a lightly greased aluminum pan spread the hamburger mixture. Next, layer the noodle mixture. Top casserole with shredded Monterey Jack Cheese.

Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until thoroughly heated.

NOTE: Please freeze the casserole, cover with aluminum foil, date and label it "St. Andrew's- Hamburger Noodle Casserole."


