

From the Pastor's Desk

"What Really Matters in Your Life?



A few years ago, a man named Joseph retired after decades of hard work. He had built a successful business, owned a beautiful home, and had enough savings to live comfortably. But something gnawed at him. One afternoon, he visited his parish priest and confessed, "I've spent my whole life building

things. Now I wonder—did I build anything that lasts?"

Joseph's question echoes the heart of this Sunday's readings. Ecclesiastes opens with the haunting refrain: "Vanity of vanities! All things are vanity!" (Eccl 1:2). The writer laments the senselessness of labor when its fruits are left to others. Psalm 90 reminds us of our fleeting days: "You turn man back to dust... Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain wisdom of heart."

In the Gospel, Jesus responds to a man demanding his share of an inheritance. Rather than settling the dispute, Jesus tells a parable about a rich man who stores up grain for years of ease. But God calls him a fool: "This night your life will be demanded of you." (Luke 12:20). The man had prepared for everything except eternity.

These readings confront us with a sobering truth: **life is short, and possessions are temporary.** But they also offer hope. St. Paul, writing to the Colossians, urges us to "seek what is above" and "put to death... greed that is idolatry" (Col 3:1,5). He reminds us that our true identity is hidden with Christ, and that we are being renewed in His image.

So what does this mean for us today? It means we must ask ourselves: **What are we building?** Are we storing up treasures that *perish*, or investing in *what matters to God?* **It means we must reorient our hearts**, not by rejecting work or possessions, but by placing them in the service of something greater. Wealth, success, and comfort are not evil, but they become dangerous when they distract us from love, mercy, and eternal purpose.

To apply this weekend's Scripture readings to your life, try to do one or more of the following Spiritual practices during the course of the week. Or, better yet, try to do <u>a different one each day</u> during the coming week:

- 1. **Declutter with Purpose** Choose one area of your life—your home, calendar, or habits—and simplify it. Ask: "Does this help me love God and others?" If not, consider letting it go.
- 2. **Practice Generosity** Give something away this week—not just money, but time, attention, or encouragement. Visit someone who is lonely. Share a meal with them. Write a note of gratitude to someone.
- 3. **Begin Each Day with a Spiritual Intention** Before checking your phone or diving into tasks, say: "Lord, help me seek what is above today." Let that prayer shape your choices and, before you go to bed, identify one thing you did that delighted the Lord.
- 4. **Reflect on Your Legacy** Ask yourself: "If my life were demanded of me tonight, what would I leave behind?" Consider writing a spiritual will—a letter to loved ones expressing your faith, hopes, and values.
- 5. Attend to the Poor Jesus warned against greed not just for its spiritual danger, but because it blinds us to the needs of others. Find one way to serve the poor this week—through our parish, a local shelter, or a simple act of kindness...and do it.

Joseph, the retired businessman, eventually found peace—not by building more, but by mentoring young entrepreneurs, volunteering at his parish, and deepening his prayer life. *He discovered that what really lasts is not stored in barns, but in hearts.* This Sunday, the Scriptures invite us to do the same. To live not for vanity, but for eternity. To be rich not in possessions, but in what matters to God.

The group will continue the "Lord, Teach Me To Pray" series focused on praying Christian Virtues.





Joseph's House Monthly Casserole Recipe

Last month we collected 30 casseroles for Joseph's House. Thank you so much to our volunteers!!!! We are grateful for your dedication to this ministry. Call or text Chris Parry at 856-906-5127 with any questions and/or to confirm you will make a casserole. Prepare one or more casseroles. All donations are greatly appreciated. We will continue to use the same recipe.

Hamburger Noodle Casserole

1 lb. hamburger 15 oz. can or jar tomato sauce 1 medium chopped onion 1 cup of green pepper 1 cup cottage cheese1 cup sour cream12 oz. egg noodles2 cups shredded Monterey Jack Cheese

Combine the hamburger, green pepper and onion and sauté until meat is cooked. Salt and pepper to taste.

Add tomato sauce and simmer for 20 minutes.

Cook noodles according to package directions.

In another bowl combine sour cream and cottage cheese.

Blend cottage cheese and sour cream mixture with the cooked noodles.

Salt and pepper to taste.

In a lightly greased aluminum pan spread the hamburger mixture. Next, layer the noodle mixture. Top casserole with shredded Monterey Jack Cheese.

Bake at 350 degrees for 20 minutes or until thoroughly heated.

NOTE: Please freeze the casserole, cover with aluminum foil, date and label it "St. Andrew's- Hamburger Noodle Casserole."


