### From the Pastor's Desk



### FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK...

One of the most significant possessions of a priest is his chalice. As priests prepare for ordination, they often contemplate the design or style of the chalice that suits them. Some chalices are passed from one priest to another, and some are designed by the priest. The

Blue chalice I use for Sunday Masses, Christmas, Easter, and Holy days, I designed before I was ordained. The chalice, created by a master craftsman in Holland, was given to me by my oldest brother and his wife as an ordination gift. The chalice cannot be mass-produced (sorry about the pun). However, I have permitted other priests/seminarians to reproduce the design when requested.

Patented under the Basilica St. Louis name, my chalice is filled with symbolism. First, the blue enamel in the chalice was made from a raw sapphire rock that was ground into a powder and then made into an enamel. If you look closely, it looks like a combination of blue and white. It is designed to capture light and reflect the brilliant blue color outward. The *blue* symbolizes our Blessed Mother, who embodied the Son of God and sent him outward to reflect God's love and mercy in the world. If you think about it, Mary was the first chalice who embodied the Son of God in her womb.

The *node* in the center encapsulates five *blue stones* representing the five members of my family. The stones are connected by a *filigree design* that represents God's love, which I believe can be found in miniature in the love of family. The *four pillars* supporting the node represent my four grandparents. The eight arches around the top represent significant people in my life who have evidenced the love of God to me in a remarkable way. (Mother Teresa, Pope John Paul II, Bishop McHugh, my dear Mother, Rev. Carl Campanova, a parishioner from my former parish (Elizabeth), and a deceased parishioner from St. Andrew Parish, who I believe is a saint (MariaKutty Peter). As you can see, the eighth and final arch is yet to be named, and I trust God will reveal that person to me before He calls me home.

On the base of my chalice is a *cross* made from my Grandmother's diamond wedding and engagement rings. Another diamond on the base was set into a tiny

rosebud by a friend and represents St. Therese, the Little Flower, to whom I am very devoted. Finally, and most significant to me, is the *heart-shaped diamond cluster* also located on the base, which came from a ring owned by my mother. I asked my mother to give me something special so that I would remember her at each Mass. When she gave me the heart-shaped cluster, she said, "Never forget a Mother's heart or her love." Indeed, my mother is the one person in this world who has loved me the most, and vice versa. You will note that I always turn the heart-shaped cluster toward me when I celebrate Mass so I can remember her intentions each time I celebrate the holy Mass.

Before Covid, I invited parishioners to participate in a special ritual on January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, the Mother of God. After the Mass, I would invite parishioners to come to the Altar and pick up the chalice, embrace it in both hands, and then pray for the special intentions of their families. When they held the chalice, they were to promise the Blessed Mother they would embody Christ in their life (as she did), and implore her to bring their family's needs to her beloved Son. This ritual and the chalice design emerged from my deep love and devotion to our Blessed Mother, who has given me the strength to endure my illness and sufferings over the past thirty-eight years. And that, dear friends, leads me to write about the beautiful Novena we began in our parish on Thursday, which will conclude on Friday, the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

I brought this Novena to our parish when I was appointed your Pastor fifteen years ago. Our Blessed Mother has always answered my prayers, and I find her intercession an essential part of my spiritual life. Likewise, I invite you to participate in this Novena by praying the Novena prayers throughout the week. The prayers are offered each day after the 8 AM Mass, and I encourage everyone to sacrifice to our Lady by coming to the 8 AM Mass and praying the Novena prayers afterward. Those who are ill, infirm, or employed can participate in the Novena by viewing the live stream archived daily. However, if you can, making the personal sacrifice to be present in the Church for the Novena is a special gift you can offer our Lady and our Lord. Most important, I invite you to offer a petition represented by a devotional candle. Devotional candles can be reserved in the vestibule after all Masses this weekend. Please complete a form and insert it in the Novena envelope, then give it to the representative at the table, or one of the priests, or drop it off at the parish office within the next day or so.
