From the Pastor's Desk



From the Pastor's Desk... 20th Sunday of OT - A Story of Fire and Faith.

In 1994, during the Rwandan genocide, a young woman named *Immaculée Ilibagiza* (ee-lee-bah-GEE-zah) hid in a tiny bathroom with seven other women for 91 days. She had <u>lost nearly everything</u>—her family, her home, her sense of

safety. But she clung to one thing: her faith. In that cramped space, she prayed the Rosary daily, sometimes for hours. She wrestled with fear, anger, and despair. But slowly, a fire began to burn within her—not of hatred, but of forgiveness.

Immaculée emerged not with vengeance, but with peace. After surviving the 1994 Rwandan genocide, she transformed her trauma into a powerful mission of healing, forgiveness, and faith. She studied electrical and mechanical engineering at the National University of Rwanda before emigrating to the United States, where she began rebuilding her life and reflecting on her purpose.

Her first book, *Left to Tell*, became a bestseller and recounts her survival and spiritual transformation. She followed it with *Led by Faith*, which explored her journey after the genocide. Immaculée became a renowned motivational speaker, sharing her story around the world to promote forgiveness, peace, and reconciliation.

According to Immaculée, it was her Catholic faith, especially devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the Rosary, that was central to her healing. Through faith, she forgave the men who killed her family, a decision she described as a spiritual breakthrough. Immaculée's life is a testament to the power of faith to overcome unimaginable darkness.

Her story echoes Jesus' words in today's Gospel: "I have come to set the earth on fire, and how I wish it were already blazing!" (Luke 12:49). This is not the gentle Jesus we often imagine. This is Jesus the disruptor—the one who brings division for the sake of truth, who calls us to live with burning conviction. Jesus speaks of a baptism He must undergo—His Passion—and the fire He longs to ignite. Then He says something startling: "Do you think that I have come to establish peace on the earth? No, I tell you, but rather division."

This isn't a contradiction of His title as Prince of Peace. It's a deeper truth: real peace comes only through truth, and truth, when lived boldly, often divides. The Gospel doesn't allow for lukewarm discipleship. It demands transformation, and transformation disrupts. Jesus warns us that following Him may strain relationships, challenge cultural norms, and cost us comfort. But it also sets our hearts ablaze with purpose.

On Friday, we celebrated the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary—her being taken body and soul into heaven. Mary's life was marked by quiet courage and unwavering conviction. She said "yes" to God knowing it would bring misunderstanding, suffering, and even division.

Mary stood at the foot of the Cross, enduring the fire of sorrow and love. Her Assumption was not just a reward—it is a sign of what happens when we let God's fire consume us completely. Mary is the model of what it means to live the Gospel with full surrender. In a world that often chooses comfort over truth, Mary shows us how to choose holiness over ease, and heaven over compromise.

Some practical ways we can do this in our lives are to:

- **1. Speak the Truth in Love.** Division doesn't mean hostility. It means clarity. Speak with compassion, but don't dilute the Gospel. If someone close to you is straying from faith, engage with humility and honesty—not silence.
- **2.** Choose Conviction Over Comfort. Let Christ's fire burn away indifference and fear. Ask yourself, where am I avoiding the hard conversations? Where am I choosing comfort over courage?
- **3. Follow Mary's Example. Mary didn't seek approval—she sought God's will.** Pray the Rosary this week, especially the Glorious Mysteries, and ask Mary to help you live with bold faith.

Jesus did not come to make us comfortable. He came to make us courageous. The fire He brings is not destructive—it's refining. If we let it, it will transform our hearts, our homes, and our world. In different ways, both Jesus and Immaculée remind us: "The love of a single heart can make a world of difference."
