FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK... "He Is Risen! A People Renewed, A Parish Alive"

An Easter Message from the Pastor

Dear Parishioners and Visitors, **Happy Easter!** Christ is risen—*The Lord is Risen Indeed, Alleluia!*

Easter is the great proclamation of our faith. It is the joyful announcement that love is stronger than hatred, mercy is stronger than sin, and life is stronger than death. The Resurrection of Jesus is not simply something we remember—it is something we live. Today, as we gather to celebrate the empty tomb, we proclaim that God is still at work among His people, renewing hearts, restoring hope, and calling us forward as disciples of the Risen Lord.

On this Easter morning, I want to begin with gratitude—gratitude to God, and gratitude to **you**, the people of this parish. On Ash Wednesday I gave you a special challenge to use the season of Lent as an opportunity to grow in your faith. From the number of participants in our Lenten programs, we certainly celebrated a **Lent Well Lived**.

Throughout the season of Lent, our parish had many opportunities to grow in faith, and you responded generously and faithfully. Some participated in the *Stay at Home Virtual Retreat*, carving out sacred time for prayer and reflection in the midst of busy lives. Others joined our book clubs, diving deeply into what it means to be **intentional disciples** or journeying spiritually through the *Autobiography of St. Thérèse of Lisieux*, learning anew the power of small acts done with great love.

Week after week, parishioners gathered for **Stations of the Cross**, walking with Christ along the way of the Cross and allowing His suffering to touch their own lives. Many came faithfully to **Wednesday Holy Hours**, spending quiet, reverent time before the Lord, placing their cares,

hopes, and questions into His loving hands. Still others attended the **Parish Mission**, seeking renewal and inspiration as we prepared our hearts for Easter.

You fasted. You prayed. You gave alms. You made your **Easter Duty**, returning to the Sacraments with humility and trust. Lent was not simply something that “happened” on the calendar—it was something that happened **in our parish**, because **you chose to engage it with sincerity and generosity**.

One of the most beautiful fruits of this Lent was the way love became visible through concrete acts of charity. You supported the **poor box**, contributed to the **South Jersey Catholic Ministries Appeal (formerly the House of Charity)**, **purchased food for the food drive, prepared casseroles** for the soup kitchen, made **sandwiches for the homeless**, and responded generously to the needs placed before you.

These are not small things. These are Gospel actions. Every dollar given, every casserole prepared, every sandwich assembled is a quiet proclamation of Easter faith—a declaration that the Risen Christ is encountered in the hungry, the homeless, the struggling, and the forgotten. Through your generosity, Christ continues to feed, clothe, comfort, and uplift His people.

I am deeply grateful for your ongoing support of the **South Jersey Catholic Ministries Appeal**, which allows our diocesan Church to extend Christ's mercy far beyond our parish boundaries. Your sacrifices make a real difference in the lives of countless individuals and families throughout South Jersey. Thank you for understanding that charity is not an optional extra of the Christian life—it is at its very heart.

One Friday evening, after celebrating the Stations of the Cross, a visitor made a beautiful comment about our parish. She said she was visiting her family and could not believe the vibrancy of St. Andrew the Apostle Parish. She asked, “What's your secret?” I shared that a vibrant parish is not defined by its buildings, its programs, or even its calendar. **A vibrant parish is defined by its people**—people who pray, who serve, who give, who welcome, and

who live their faith beyond Sunday.

A vibrant parish is one where:

- **Faith is deepened** through worship and prayer
- **Disciples are formed** through learning and reflection
- **Charity flows** naturally into service
- **Hospitality** opens doors and hearts
- **Stewardship is embraced** as a joyful response to God's generosity.

This parish is vibrant because **you** make it so. You volunteer your time and talents. You support parish ministries and outreach efforts. You give generously to sustain the mission of the Church, including pledges to the **Capital Campaign**, ensuring that our parish will continue to serve future generations. You greet one another warmly, reach out to those who are new, and care for those who are hurting. In short, you live the Resurrection.

As we move from Lent into Easter, the question before us is not **"What did we do?"** but **"Who are we becoming?"**

Easter invites us to carry forward what we have begun:

- To remain, people of prayer
- To continue serving the poor
- To deepen our discipleship
- To live with compassion, courage, and joy

Let the holy habits formed during Lent shape the way we live throughout the year. Let Easter joy fuel our commitment to be Christ's presence in the world. To those who worship with us regularly, thank you for calling this parish your spiritual home. Your faithfulness, generosity, and love give life to our community.

To those who are visiting us this Easter—family members, friends, neighbors, or those returning after time away—**welcome, welcome, welcome.** We are truly glad you are here. Know that this parish is a place where you are valued, where questions are welcome, where faith is nurtured, and where no one walks alone. If you are searching, longing, or simply curious, please know that you are always welcome here—not just on Easter, but every day.

As we celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord, may we all feel the joy of Easter. May it fill our hearts and your homes. May the Risen Christ strengthen you, renew you,

and send you forth as witnesses of hope. Thank you again for all that you do to make this parish a place of faith, generosity, and welcome. Thank you for being a **vibrant parish**—a living sign that **Christ is risen and alive among His people.**

Religious Education Classes for Children

It is time to enroll your child in our Religious Education program for September. The registration form can be found on our website or in the church vestibule for your convenience. Please complete the registration form and return it to the religious education office or parish office as soon as possible.

Also, we are always in need of catechists, substitute catechists and classroom assistants throughout the school year. If you have an hour or two to assist us, we would be most grateful for additional volunteers for our religious education program.

Sacramental Catch Up Program for Children

The Sacramental Catch Up program is designed for families with children in grades 3 - 12 who have been baptized Catholic but have missed the usual window for receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. Through the Sacramental Catch Up program, we can assist your children to continue their faith formation and receive the sacraments appropriate for their age and stage of faith formation.

Over the course of the year, children and parents (at least one of the parents) will go through formation for First Eucharist, First Reconciliation, and/or Confirmation together to help the whole family prepare the child to receive the sacraments. Classes meet on alternate Sundays from 8:45 AM to 9:45 AM in the St. Andrew's Parish Hall from September through May.

Your Ministries

St. Andrew the Apostle Grief Support Group Wednesday, April 15 at 4:00 PM • Upper Room

Grief Hurts. When we've lost someone we love, it can feel as though we've lost a part of ourselves. Sometimes we wonder if we will ever feel whole again. The pain of grief can be emotional, spiritual and sometimes even physical. Some people cry a lot, others not at all, and many cry now and then. It is all normal, and it is all okay.

Feeling sad is a natural response to losing someone who was an important part of our life. Many people experience a lack of energy and sadness while grieving. Some describe being "in a fog" and finding it difficult to perform simple tasks. Some people want to be around their friends and family, and others prefer to be left alone. Grief looks different with each person who experiences it.

St. Andrew's offers a peer grief support group for persons who have experienced a loss. It can be very helpful to share your grief with others who understand and share your faith. Our faith is a great source of hope and comfort at a time of loss. We believe in Eternal Life and Christ's promise: "I am the Resurrection and the Life, he who believes in me, though he dies, yet he shall live." John 11:25

The next session of our Grief Support Group will begin on Wednesday, April 15th from 4PM to 5:30 PM and continues for seven more weeks. Join us!


