FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK
Fifth Sunday of Easter:
"Do Not Let Your Hearts Be Troubled"

*Fifth Sunday of Easter –
John 14:1–12*

When I was very young—so young that I was still wearing plastic pants over a cloth diaper—we took a family vacation to **Wildwood, New Jersey**. Several of my mother's brothers

and sisters were there as well, and the beach was filled with familiar faces. My father set up our blanket and umbrella among the many umbrellas of our relatives. The sun was shining, the breeze off the ocean was gentle, and there was a deep sense of happiness and security. I occupied myself digging in the sand with my red pail and yellow shovel. To this day, it remains my earliest clear memory.

At one point, something caught my attention. A short distance away, another child began feeding snacks to a flock of seagulls. I was fascinated. Leaving my shovel behind, I wandered just a few steps away—no more than several yards—to watch the birds gather and scatter.

Then it happened. I turned around and suddenly could not see my parents. All I could see were rows and rows of beach umbrellas and strangers. In an instant, my feeling of safety vanished. Even though I was surrounded by people, I felt completely alone. I began to scream and cry, terrified beyond words.

Immediately, my father sprang into action. He scooped me up, held me tightly, and spoke calmly until my fear began to fade. I buried my face into his neck and clung to his shoulders with all my strength. The trouble in my heart eased—not because the beach had changed, but because I was back in the arms of someone I trusted.

That childhood memory captures something essential about today's Gospel. When we feel lost—even in the

middle of a crowd—what we need most is not directions, but *presence*. And in **John 14**, Jesus offers exactly that.

In today's Gospel, Jesus is speaking to His disciples **on the night before His death**. He knows the cross is coming. He knows their world is about to be turned upside down. The disciples sense that something is wrong, and fear has begun to creep into their hearts. So Jesus begins with words meant to calm them: *"Do not let your hearts be troubled."*

These are not empty words or false reassurance. Jesus is not pretending that hardship is going away. Instead, He is telling them—and us—that we do not have to face fear alone. Jesus speaks about His Father's house with many dwelling places, words that have brought comfort to believers for generations. But before He speaks about heaven, He speaks about relationship. He assures His disciples that He is going ahead of them and that they belong with Him.

Thomas, ever honest, asks what many of us would ask: *"Lord, we do not know where you are going. How can we know the way?"* Jesus responds with one of the most familiar and comforting statements in all of Scripture: *"I am the way and the truth and the life."* Jesus does not hand them a map. He does not give detailed instructions. He gives them Himself.

This is important for us to remember. **Faith is not about having every answer. It is about trusting the One who walks with us when answers are hard to find.** Many older parishioners know this well. You have lived long enough to experience joy and sorrow, health and illness, beginnings and endings. You may sometimes look at the world today and feel unsettled by how quickly things change. You may worry about your health, your children, or what the future holds.

Jesus' words, *"Do not let your hearts be troubled,"* are not a promise that life will be easy. They are a promise that we are not alone. To follow Jesus as "the way" means staying close to Him in simple, steady ways. It means prayer that may be quiet and brief, but sincere. **It means trusting God with today instead of worrying too much about tomorrow.** It means choosing patience and kindness, especially when we feel tired or discouraged.

Jesus also tells His disciples that those who believe in Him will do the works that He does. For most of us, that does not mean dramatic miracles. It means everyday acts of faithfulness: listening to someone who needs to be heard, offering encouragement, praying for others, showing gentleness, and remaining faithful even when it is difficult. These small acts of love matter more than we realize.

One of the great blessings of faith later in life is peace—not because every problem is solved, but because our hearts rest in God's care. **When fear returns, as it inevitably does, Jesus invites us to place our trust in Him again.** Each morning, we can say, "Lord, I trust You with this day." Each evening, we can thank Him for walking beside us, even when the day was hard. Over time, this trust becomes a way of life.

As we celebrate the **Fifth Sunday of Easter**, remember this: **you are not lost, and you are not alone.** When the world feels confusing or overwhelming, Jesus is already near—ready to scoop us in his arms or take us by the hand, just as a father does when his child is lost and frightened. Today, let His words settle deep in your heart: *"Do not let your hearts be troubled. Believe in God; believe also in me."*

Veritas from August 9-15 at **Camp Lakota in Wurtsboro, NY (7th-9th grade; \$550 per child)**.

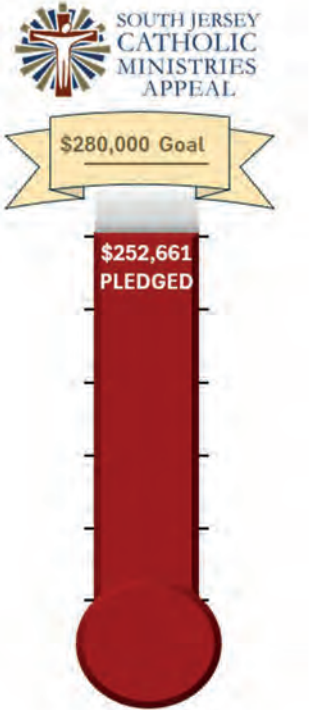
