**FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK:
Under the Protection of
the Sacred Heart of Jesus**

There was once a man who carried a heavy heart for many months. He had lost his peace, his sleep, and almost his hope. Outwardly, he continued to work, smile, and speak kindly, but inwardly he felt burdened by worry for his family, regret over past mistakes, and fear about the future. One evening, he entered a quiet church and sat in the last pew. He had no great speech prepared for God. He simply whispered, "Jesus, I am tired." In that silence, he looked upon an image of the Sacred Heart and remembered the Lord's words: "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, and I will give you rest... for I am gentle and humble of heart." He did not leave with every problem solved, but he did leave with something deeper: the assurance that he was not alone. The Heart of Jesus had room for his sorrow, his weakness, and his need. **That is why the Feast of the Sacred Heart matters so much. It reminds us that the Lord does not turn away from wounded hearts. He draws them close to His own.**

On Friday, June 12th, the Church celebrated the Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus. The bishops of the United States consecrated our **nation** to the Sacred Heart, and Bishop Williams consecrated our **Diocese** to the protection of the Heart of Christ. **This weekend, I invite you to renew your trust in the love of Jesus, who is gentle and humble of heart, as I dedicate our parish and parishioners under the protection of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.**

The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus grew over centuries within the life of the Church, but it became especially beloved through the revelations received by Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque in seventeenth-century France. **In those visions, the Lord revealed His Heart as burning with love for humanity, yet also wounded by indiffer-**

ence, sin, and forgetfulness. He called the faithful to deeper love, reparation, trust, Holy Hours, and devotion on the First Fridays. Over time, this devotion spread throughout the Church and was strengthened by the teaching of the popes. The Feast of the Sacred Heart was extended to the universal Church in the nineteenth century, and in our own day the Church continues to present the Sacred Heart as a living sign of the tender and saving love of Christ. The bishops of the United States have encouraged the faithful to enter more deeply into this devotion as they prepare to consecrate the nation to the Sacred Heart and to unite prayer with concrete acts of mercy and Eucharistic adoration.

The Scripture readings for this Solemnity reveal why the Sacred Heart is so precious to us. In 1 John 4:7-16, we heard the great truth: "God is love." Love is not merely something God does; love is who God is. **The Heart of Jesus makes that love visible.** In Jesus, divine love takes flesh, speaks, heals, forgives, suffers, and saves. In the Gospel, Matthew 11:25-30, **the Lord invites the weary to come to Him and learn from Him, "for I am gentle and humble of heart."** The Sacred Heart is therefore not only a symbol; it is a revelation of the very character of Christ. His heart is not harsh, proud, or distant. His heart is open. His heart is merciful. His heart receives sinners, strengthens the weak, and gives rest to burdened souls. To draw near to the Sacred Heart is to draw near to the mercy of God Himself.

For that reason, **it is profoundly fitting that our country, our Diocese, and our parish be placed under the protection of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.** When a **nation** is entrusted to the Sacred Heart, we ask Christ to purify what is wounded in public life and to guide us in truth, justice, mercy, and peace. **We pray that hearts hardened by division may be softened by grace,** and that our common life may be renewed by the Gospel.

When a **Diocese** is dedicated to the Sacred Heart, **the local Church asks to be formed more deeply in the love of Christ** so that bishops, priests, deacons, religious, and laity may serve with fidelity and compassion.

When a **parish** is placed under the protection of the Sacred Heart, it becomes not just an institution, but a family

gathered around the love of Jesus. We ask the Lord to **ble^ss our worship, strengthen our marriages and families, comfort the sick, guide our young people, reconcile sinners, and deepen charity among neighbors.** Such dedication is not magic. It is a solemn act of trust. **It means we are choosing to belong more fully to Christ and to shape our lives according to His merciful Heart.**

This year, that act of trust takes on special beauty for us at St. Andrew the Apostle Parish. As our bishops dedicated the nation and our Diocese joined in that prayer, we, too, **desire to place our parish and parishioners under the loving protection of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.** In a world marked by anxiety, loneliness, violence, and uncertainty, the Church points us not to an idea but to a Person: Jesus Christ, whose Heart burns with love for His people.

The Sacred Heart teaches us that no suffering is unnoticed, no sinner is beyond mercy, and no home is too ordinary to become a dwelling place of grace. If we open our lives to the Heart of Christ, He will teach us how to love one another more patiently, forgive more readily, pray more faithfully, and serve more generously. May this solemnity renew our confidence that the Heart of Jesus is a refuge for every soul, a source of healing for every family, and a hope for the Church and the world.

As we dedicate our parish to the protection of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, I invite all parishioners to join in a nine-day novena as we entrust our lives to Him. The novena begins today, Saturday, June 13th after the 8:00 AM Mass. The novena will be prayed after the Mass at 8:00 AM, 10:00 AM, and 6:00 PM on Sunday, June 14th. On the following days, the novena will be prayed after the 8:00 AM daily Mass and will conclude on Sunday, June 21st. We warmly encourage everyone to take part and to bring your families, intentions, and needs to the Heart of Christ. As we pray together, may the Sacred Heart of Jesus renew our parish in faith, strengthen our homes in love, and draw us more deeply into His mercy. **If you are unable to attend the morning Mass and novena, you may join us each evening at 7:00 PM for the novena prayers, either in person or by livestream, for the recitation of the Novena Prayers.**

I also strongly recommend that the head of every household **dedicate their family to the protection of the Sacred Heart of Jesus.** You can do so by doing two things: **First, obtain an image of the Sacred Heart (Artwork, Statue, etc.) and place it in a prominent place in your home,** so that all who see it are reminded to imitate Jesus' heart. **Second, gather your family together in front of the sacred image of Jesus' most sacred heart and recite the following prayer together,** or have the head of the household recite the prayer for all.

Prayer for the dedication of families and households to the Sacred Heart of Jesus: Lord Jesus Christ, gentle and humble of heart, we place our home and family under the protection of Your Most Sacred Heart. Reign over our house with Your peace. Be our comfort in sorrow, our strength in trial, our patience in difficulty, and our joy in all blessings. Forgive our sins, heal our wounds, and draw us closer to one another in charity. We ask for your blessing on the parents, children, grandparents, relatives, and all who enter this home. Let our family be a place of prayer, mercy, honesty, and love. Teach us to listen to Your word, to trust in Your providence, and to serve those in need. Protect us from all evil, keep us faithful to Your Church, and make our hearts more like Your own. Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, we place all that we are and all that we have into Your loving care. Amen. (End the family dedication by praying the Lord's Prayer (the Our Father) together as a family.

11th Sunday in Ordinary Time: Stewardship Love

“As you go, make this proclamation: ‘The kingdom of heaven is at hand.’” MATTHEW 10:7

Many of us take our lives for granted. We think we have plenty of time to “repent.” Maybe we should live with a little more urgency in making things right with God. This is the difference in living our stewardship out of obligation versus out of love. Obligation implies we do the minimum required. Love implies we want a relationship. God wants us to be with Him in Heaven forever, but He also wants to be in relationship with us right now, while we are on earth. Start this second – invite the Lord into your heart.

Religious Education Classes for Children

Catholic religious education programs, often referred to as CCD or PREP, aim to deepen children's understanding of the Catholic faith and prepare them for sacraments such as First Communion and Confirmation and to live out their Catholic faith. Our program includes classroom instruction, prayer, and liturgical celebrations, with a focus on scripture, doctrine, and living out one's faith. Parents play a vital role, with the Church assisting in their responsibility to nurture their child's faith.

It is time to enroll your child in our Religious Education program for September!

The registration form can be found on our website or in the church vestibule for your convenience. Please complete the registration form and return it to the religious education office or parish office as soon as possible. Information about the various class options we offer can be found on the church website under the Religious Education tab.

Please give us a call if you have any questions about our program, or if you have any questions about how to register. We're here to help!

We are always in need of catechists, substitute catechists and classroom assistants throughout the school year. *If you have an hour or two to assist us, we would be most grateful for additional volunteers for our religious education program.*

Sacramental Catch Up Program for Children

The Sacramental Catch Up program is designed for families with children in grades 3 - 12 who have been baptized Catholic but have missed the usual window for receiving the Sacraments of Initiation. Through the Sacramental catch up program, we can assist your children to continue their faith formation and receive the sacraments appropriate for their age and stage of faith formation.

Over the course of the year, children and parents (at least one of the parents) will go through formation for First Eucharist, First Reconciliation, and/or Confirmation together to help the whole family prepare the child to receive the sacraments. Classes meet on alternate Sundays from 9:00 AM to 9:50AM in the St. Andrew's Parish Hall from September through May.

Order of Christian Initiation of Adults

The OCIA distinguishes between several groups:

Catechumen: A non-baptized person desiring all three Sacraments of Initiation: Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist.

Candidate for Confirmation and Eucharist: A person already baptized either in the Catholic Church or a Christian denomination whose baptism is valid and desires to receive the Sacraments of Confirmation and Eucharist.

Candidate for Confirmation only: A person who is already baptized and has received the Sacrament of Eucharist but needs to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation to complete his/her Sacraments of Christian Initiation.
