**23<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of OT: Where Two or Three Gather: A Week of Reconciliation, Gratitude, and Remembrance**

In the days after September 11, 2001, one of the most haunting images was not only the smoke rising over a wounded city, but the sight of ordinary people walking toward danger while everyone else was running away. **Firefighters**

climbed stairs they might never descend. **Police officers** held back panic so others could find safety. **Emergency workers** entered dust, darkness, and confusion because someone inside still needed help. That image remains a kind of parable: **Love is not sentiment. Love moves toward the person in need, even when it costs something.**

**That is the kind of love Jesus teaches in this Sunday's Gospel**, Matthew 18:15–20. At first glance, the passage may sound like a procedure for handling conflict: speak privately, bring witnesses, involve the community, pray together. Jesus is not giving us a cold policy manual. **He is teaching us how a Christian community refuses to give up on one another.** The goal is not to win an argument, expose a sinner, or prove who is right. The goal is to “win back” a brother or sister. In other words, reconciliation is not a side project of the Christian life; it is one of the clearest signs that Christ is truly among us.

Jesus knows that wounds happen even among believers. Families misunderstand each other. Parishioners disappoint one another. Friends grow distant. Words are said, silence hardens, and pride tells us to wait for the other person to make the first move. **However, the Gospel asks something braver: go, speak, listen, and seek communion.** Correction, when it is Christian, it is never humiliation. It is charity with courage. It is the humility to say, “**Our relationship matters enough that I will not let resentment have the last word.**”

**This message arrives as our parish enters a week filled with opportunities to live the Gospel. Monday is Labor Day**, a moment to thank God for the dignity of work and for all whose labor sustains our homes, parish, schools, businesses, and communities. Work is not merely a

paycheck; **it is a way of serving the common good. Whether** one builds, teaches, heals, repairs, protects, cooks, cleans, manages, volunteers, or cares quietly for family, **honest labor becomes holy when offered to God and directed toward love of neighbor.**

**Tuesday, September 8, the Church celebrates the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary.** Mary's birth is like the first light before sunrise: the dawn that announces Christ is near. Our parish has a beautiful tradition of honoring Our Lady's birthday with the **2000 Hail Mary devotion, beginning at 7:00 AM and concluding at approximately 6:00 PM, with an 8:00 AM Mass included.** Some may be able to stay for hours; others may be able to stop in for ten minutes. All are welcome. Bring a petition. Bring a burden. Bring your gratitude. Bring someone in your heart who needs Mary's intercession. **A single Hail Mary prayed with faith can become a doorway for grace.**

Then on **Friday, September 11, we remember a day of tragedy, courage, and sacrifice.** We pray for those who died in the attacks, for their families, for all who still carry wounds of body or spirit, and for the firefighters, police personnel, emergency rescue workers, and first responders who serve our local communities of Gibbsboro and Voorhees. We also remember those who have died this past year. Memory, for Christians, is not simply looking backward. **It is allowing the past to teach us how to live now—with gratitude, vigilance, compassion, and peace.**

**So, what can we do this week? First, practice the Gospel at home.** If there is someone you need to forgive, begin praying for that person today. If there is someone you need to approach, do it gently and privately, without accusation. **Second, let Labor Day become a prayer of gratitude:** thank someone whose work makes your life better. **Third, come to church on Tuesday for Mary's birthday.** Stay as long as you can, even briefly, and entrust your family and our parish to Our Lady. **Fourth, on September 11, pause for prayer.** Thank a first responder. If you see a firefighter, police officer, EMT, rescue worker, or dispatcher, offer a word of appreciation. If you know someone grieving a loss from this past year, reach out with a call, note, or visit.

The Gospel promise is clear: “**Where two or three are gathered together in my name, there am I in the midst of them.**” Christ is present when we pray the Hail Mary together. He is present when workers serve with integrity. He is present when first responders run toward danger. He is present when a parish remembers its dead, honors its servants, and refuses to let division win. **This**



week may our parish become what the Gospel asks us to be: a community brave enough to reconcile, humble enough to pray, grateful enough to serve, and faithful enough to remember—**because wherever love moves toward another, Christ is already there.**

Grief Hurts. When we've lost someone we love, it can feel as though we've lost a part of ourselves. Sometimes we wonder if we will ever feel whole again. The pain of grief can be emotional, spiritual and sometimes even physical. Some people cry a lot, others not at all, and many cry now and then. It is all normal, and it is all okay.

Feeling sad is a natural response to losing someone who was an important part of our life. Many people experience a lack of energy and sadness while grieving. Some describe being "in a fog" and finding it difficult to perform simple tasks. Some people want to be around their friends and family, and others prefer to be left alone. Grief looks different with each person who experiences it.

St. Andrew the Apostle offers a peer grief support group for persons who have experienced a loss. It can be very helpful to share your grief with others who understand and share your faith. Our faith is a great source of hope and comfort at a time of loss. We believe in Eternal Life and Christ's promise: "I am the Resurrection and the Life, he who believes in me, though he dies, yet he shall live." John 11:25
