

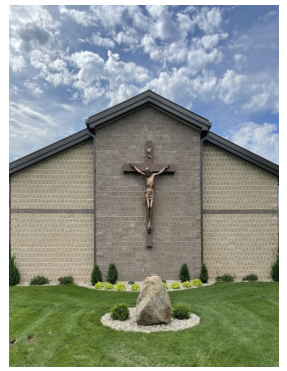

Beloved in the Lord,

With Epiphany still echoing in our hearts, we turn to this brief interim period between the principal liturgical seasons of our Church's calendar, readying our souls for what is to come with lent and the meditation on Our Lord's passion just around the corner.

It is called "Ordinary Time." The word coming from the Latin "Ordo" which speaks to an ordering of things, the truth that we have a nature, and a stable creation within which we live. In the not-so-distant past of the Church, these Sundays between the Christmas and Easter cycles were referred to as the "Sundays after Epiphany." This was not just to give us a practical calendar to follow, but rather indicated that these Sundays were descending from the reference point of the Feast of Epiphany.

If Epiphany is the Feast in which Jesus has shown us Himself for who he truly is, at once Lord and Master, and Nearest and Dearest friend to mankind, then the Divine "Ordering" of our lives must be reflective of this reality. As much as these Sundays are ordered by Epiphany, so much more so are our lives meant to be ordered by who Christ is.
