Beloved in the Lord.

I imagine that, by now, most of our parishioners have seen the video from the diocese and/or the banners in the gathering area of the church about the Diocesan Synod. I also imagine that many still do not know what the synod is for or about. This is completely understandable, in one way, because we haven't had a synod of any variety in our diocese for literally a century! Be at peace. In the near future, our parish will hear more about the diocesan synod and come to a fuller understanding of how each member will be able to take part in it.

This last week all the priests of the diocese took part in our annual continuing education days. This year, rather than have standard-issue educational presentations, we made use of the time by completing our consultation for the synod. We priests gained a lot of clarity about the particularities of the synod consultations as a result. Stay tuned for more about how our parish will be involved. I am hopeful that our parish consultation for the Diocesan synod will be not only informative to our bishop about what needs to happen next for the mission of the Diocese, but also assistant to our parish in discovering and pursuing our own goals.

In the meantime, I can recommend reading the Catechism of the Catholic Church, paragraphs 91 - 93 on the principle of the Supernatural Sense of Faith (Sensus Fidei).

Additionally, if you'd like to go deeper, Dr. Richard DeClue wrote a good article on the Sensus Fidei for the Word on Fire Institute entitled: 'Sensus Fidei': What Does It Mean?
