Holy Day of Obligation

Monday this week is a Holy Day of Obligation: The Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Advent has often been a very Marian time, as we enter into preparation with Mary for the coming of the Lord, her son.

At St. Robert, we will have Masses at:

8am: "Low" Mass, i.e. no music or incense used

6pm: "High" Mass, i.e. both Music and Incense used

Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe: 6 pm, Friday

Please be advised that there will be **no 8am Mass on Friday**.

Rather, Mass will be celebrated for the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe at 6pm by Fr. Oscar Duarte, and the traditional celebration will be kept following Mass in the Parish Hall. When our Blessed Lady came to St. Juan Diego, she appeared as being with child. Let us pray well with Our Lady's motherhood of Our God and Lord as we prepare for Christmas!

Lessons and Carols: 6:30pm Saturday

Lessons and Carols Services go back to 1918. The first Lessons and Carols was offered at Cambridge at King's College. The Dean of the college had been an army chaplain in World War I and upon returning home to England, wanted to help return people to joy after the long darkness of war. Lessons and Carols services vary and are even used multi-denominationally, but they all include singing of some of the most uplifting music in the Christian tradition, Advent and Christmas Music, and reading the "Lessons," i.e. the verses from Sacred Scripture which foreshadow the coming of the Messiah.

At St. Robert, our Lessons and Carols Service will be at **6:30pm, Saturday Night, December 13th**, following the evening Mass. This event has been advertised in town, so it is an opportunity to invite our fellow townsfolk of North Manchester and the surrounding area to our church. Let us show our neighbors good Christian hospitality as we welcome them into our home. This season requires such charity. I am sure that our parish will be up to the task!


