Easter is a sacramental kind of season!

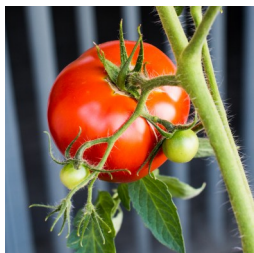

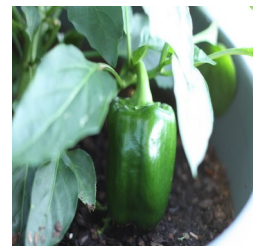
### Enthronement Night: 6:30pm, Friday, May 9th

We are excited for another adventure to know Christ! Watch for more details as time goes on.

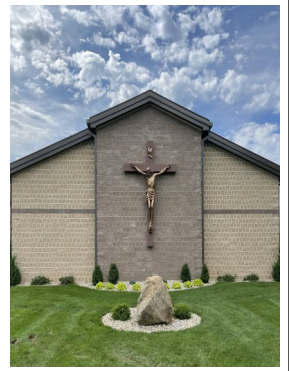
