This last week, the Church celebrated the Feast Day of Saint Louis Marie de Montfort which also marked the 310th anniversary of the Saint's death. Saint Louis was one of the Church's most avid advocates for devotion to Our Blessed Mother, claiming that this devotion was one of the surest paths to knowledge and love of her son!

Of the Holy Rosary, Saint Louis de Montfort said:

"If priests and religious have an obligation to meditate on the great truths of our holy religion in order to live up to their vocation worthily, the same obligation, then, is just as much incumbent upon the laity — because of the fact that every day they meet with spiritual dangers which might make them lose their souls. Therefore, they should arm themselves with the frequent meditation on the life, virtues and sufferings of Our Blessed Lord — which are so beautifully contained in the mysteries of the Holy Rosary!"

Our Lady in her numerous apparitions has made known her desire that the Faithful should daily take up the holy Rosary. It is a true school of contemplative prayer and will necessarily strengthen us for the pilgrimage of life and lead us closer to Jesus. Pray the Rosary!

We are excited for another adventure to know Christ! Watch for more details as time goes on.

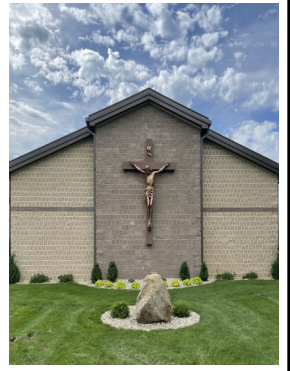

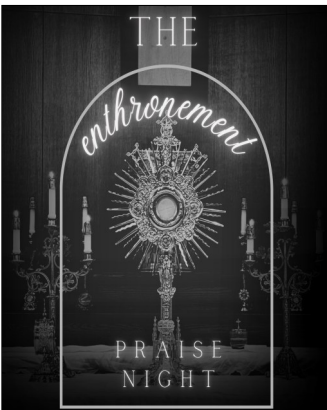
