Next weekend we celebrate the Solemn Feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, otherwise known by its Latin name: "Corpus Christi" Sunday. At the conclusion of the 9am Mass on this day we will have a procession with the Blessed Sacrament to an altar set up outside the church. (If you remember, we went out in front of the big crucifix on the front of the parish hall last year.)

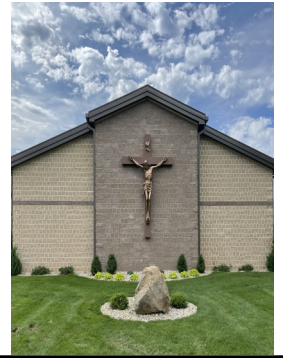
