As we give of ourselves in alms so also should we give of ourselves in prayer. Please see this Invitation to Prayer from the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops for the protection of the unborn:

"History was recently made when Planned Parenthood and other big abortion businesses were banned from receiving federal Medicaid dollars for one year. Planned Parenthood immediately sued in a federal court and the judge swiftly granted part of a preliminary injunction, requiring the abortion giant's taxpayer funding to continue. Otherwise, children's lives could be saved every day.
