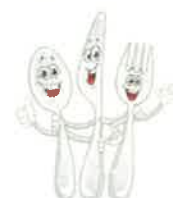

Where do young people learn to enjoy the outdoor wonderland of Northern Minnesota?

Even more importantly, where do young people learn grounding values for life as an adult?

And where do young people learn to be independent and resourceful?

And where do they learn to take charge and lead others?

Scouting is sadly under-appreciated by most of the United States these days, but it is a tremendous program, and your church makes the wise choice to support it. A scout unit cannot exist without a sponsoring institution, and you are the sponsoring institution for Scout Troop 4025.

We are an active, energetic group of boys ages 11 to 17. Right now, we have 26 active youth in the Troop, and we have been gradually growing over the years. We have scouts who are just starting out in the program, and we have scouts who have been with us for years and are about to be “too old.”

We meet every Monday evening, all year round, from 7 to 8:30 pm. During the school year, we meet in your gym and fellowship hall. During the summer, we meet outside. At the meetings, we learn basic scouting outdoor skills, we plan campouts, we play team-building games, and we earn merit badges.

We have a campout every month, all year round, including during the winter. We camp out if it's hot or cold, still or windy, raining or snowing. We go out and have fun, and the scouts learn important life skills. I like to say that, in scouts, kids learn skills they will use their entire lives!

You might wonder why we camp out in the middle of the winter. We do plenty of training on how to stay warm and have fun in the cold, and the scouts are ready for it. They come back from those winter outings realizing that we can have lots of fun outside in the winter, and they build incredible self-confidence: they realize that they just did something that most people don't even consider doing!

With the support of this church, we are teaching and training these young people to be the reliable, solid, value-rich leaders of our future that our world so desperately needs.
