



# Course Policies and Etiquette

Macoby Run Golf Course aims to provide a respectful and enjoyable experience for golfers of all skill levels. Adhering to proper golf etiquette and playing at an appropriate pace of play ensures that everyone can fully appreciate their time on the course. Please review and follow these guidelines:

## **PACE OF PLAY:**

- Macoby Run will enforce a pace of 4 hours and 15 minutes maximum for a group of four golfers to play 18 holes. 10-15 minutes per hole.
- Be aware of your group's position relative to the group ahead. Please keep pace with the group ahead of you whether there are golfers in view behind your group or not.
- Adopt a "ready golf" approach, where players hit when ready rather than strictly adhering to the order of play.

## **RESPECT FOR OTHERS & COURSE:**

- Allow faster groups to play through if your group is falling behind.
- Be mindful of other golfers, course staff, wildlife, and property while on the course.

## **COURSE CARE:**

- Repair ball marks on the greens, replace divots, and rake bunkers after use.
- Follow any specific course guidelines regarding cart paths, designated areas, and course maintenance.
- Please use trash cans that are located on every tee box.

## **TEE TIME MANAGEMENT:**

- Arrive and be ready to tee off at least 10 minutes before your scheduled tee time.
- In the event of a no-show, a one-time warning will be issued as a courtesy. After that, Macoby Run reserves the right to charge you in full for any bookings that are no-showed.
- We recommend beginners to not book a morning tee time on weekends.

## **CART LIABILITY & ALCOHOL POLICY:**

- Drivers of our golf carts must be at least 18 years of age and have a valid driver's license.
- By accepting a key you are liable for any damages to the property incurred during your round.
- No alcoholic beverages or coolers shall be brought on to golf course property at any time (including the parking lot) and the facility has the right to search coolers and confiscate any outside alcohol at any time. Coolers are available for rent when you purchase beer in the Proshop (\$20 deposit must be left, returned when you return the cooler after your round)

Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in a warning from course staff or, in severe cases, removal from the course. Thank you for your understanding and cooperation in upholding these guidelines, and we hope you have a wonderful round!
