Our Environmental Approach

In July 2026, Escape This achieved **Sustainable Tourism Accreditation**, recognising our commitment to responsible environmental practices. We will continue building on this foundation, with the goal of progressing towards **EcoStar and emissions-reduction accreditation**.

OUR FOCUS	Operate efficiently within existing urban venues, reduce unnecessary energy and resource use, extend the life of materials, and minimise environmental risk.
Energy Efficiency	We use 12V LED lighting wherever possible . Closing procedures require lights, air conditioning, machinery, technical systems and warehouse equipment to be switched off when not required. Regular maintenance of lighting, audio, screens and technical equipment helps systems run efficiently and extends equipment life.
Waste Reduction & Reuse	Props, furniture, locks, set pieces and equipment are repaired and reused wherever practical. Offcuts, spare materials and usable components from one build are retained for future experiences or maintenance. Recycling is used where available and general waste is disposed of through appropriate collection systems.
Responsible Purchasing	Purchase requests are managed through our internal system so they can be reviewed, approved and consolidated before ordering. This reduces unnecessary purchasing, waste and transport, while durability, suitability and energy efficiency are considered when equipment must be replaced.

Low-Impact Urban Tourism

Escape This is an indoor, fictional and story-led attraction operating within existing built environments in Perth CBD and Northbridge. Our experiences do not enter natural habitats, involve wildlife or require guests to access environmentally sensitive areas, keeping direct impact on flora and fauna minimal.

Visitor Impact	Customer activity is contained within our venues and managed through scheduled bookings, controlled group sizes and staff supervision. Our central locations are accessible by public transport, walking, rideshare and nearby parking, giving guests lower-emission transport options where suitable.
Venue Care	Rubbish is removed regularly, premises are maintained carefully and pest control is undertaken only through appropriate providers when required. Clean, secure operating procedures help prevent waste from affecting surrounding public spaces or local wildlife.
Environmental Risk Management	Contingency planning covers risks relevant to an urban attraction, including water leaks, chemical spills, fire or smoke damage, waste issues and equipment failure. Staff prioritise safety, isolate affected areas, notify management, contain issues where safe and engage qualified contractors or emergency services where required. Incidents are recorded and reviewed to reduce recurrence.

OUR COMMITMENT
For Escape This, environmental sustainability is practical and ongoing: use less where possible, maintain and reuse what we already have, manage risk responsibly and deliver memorable tourism experiences without placing pressure on WA's natural environments.
