St JOHN HENRY NEWMAN: Yesterday, 1 November 2025, Saint John Henry Newman was declared the 38th Doctor of the Church. This great honour was conferred by Pope Leo XIV in St Peter's Square, Vatican City, and marks the culmination of events celebrating the Jubilee of Education. Earlier last week, Pope Leo named Saint John Henry Newman "patron of the Church's educational mission alongside St Thomas Aquinas."
