CONFIRMATION: The dates and times for Confirmation is Saturday, 27th June. As last year, there will be two services — 11.00am at St Brendan's and 2.00 pm at Our Lady's. Confirmation will be celebrated within a Service of the Word to allow Fr Mark time to celebrate each service and to prepare for the two parish evening Masses.

SVP: The SVP run a foodbank as sadly those who are in need grows all year round. All our food parcels are distributed to those who need them in our Catholic Schools and parishes, here is a list of items in most need: tinned spaghetti, tinned tomatoes, pasta sauce, rice, tinned vegetables, tinned meat, tinned fish, tinned fruit, tinned custard and rice pudding, breakfast cereals, biscuits, coffee, long life juice, UHT milk, disposable razors, shampoo, deodorant, shower gel, toilet rolls, toothpaste. If you can donate, please leave your items with a steward at the back of the church. ALSO, if anyone is struggling with the cost of living, food, fuel etc or you know of anyone, please contact the St Vincent de Paul society, directly or through the Parish office.

PERMANENT DIACONATE: Many of us see deacons serving at the altar, but their call is truly to be a 'guardian of service' in the Church. A deacon's ministry isn't just within the walls of the church building; it is out in the world – in our workplaces, our hospitals, our schools and with the marginalised within our community. It is a unique vocation for men, many of whom are married and have families, who feel called to serve God through the Word, through service at the Altar, and doing works of charity within the community. If you have ever felt a nudge in your heart to serve more deeply, or if others have told you that you have a 'servant's heart, 'the Lord may be calling you. For married men, this is a journey shared with your wife, and her support is a vital part of the discernment.
