MOTHERS DAY: Next Sunday is Mother's Day and we have some lovely Mother's Day cards at the back of the Church in the temporary Repository. We also have some items for St Patrick's day and for First Holy Communions and Confirmations. Please have a look, as the prices are very reasonable.

PRAYER FOR PEACE IN THE HOLY LAND: Cardinal Vincent and Bishop David have asked to have a time of prayer for peace in the Holy Land this Friday, 8 March. We will have a Holy Hour from 5.15 to 6.15, Stations of the Cross at 6.15 and Mass at 7pm. We pray that the suffering will end, and peace and reconciliation will be promoted

OFFERTORY ENVELOPES 2024/25: Offertory envelopes will be available at all Masses on the 16/17 March. These new envelopes will be for the new joint account of St Brendan & St Patrick's – Corby. Please note that offertory envelopes are for all and not just taxpayers. However, if you are a taxpayer, we can claim an extra 25p per pound you donate from the government, at no extra cost to you – it is free money!

Everyone who is a taxpayer will need to sign a new gift aid form for the new financial year and you will be allocated a new envelope number.

The most asked question we receive at this time of year is, 'How much should I give each week' – this is something Fr Mark cannot answer as everyone's available income is different. The financial year gives us all an opportunity to reflect on how we give financial support to the Parish in order to keep the Church running, as like everyone else, we have been hit by the increase in utility bills and other expenses.

Another way to support our parish is by Standing Order. Payment is made to the Diocese Account under our Parish's name and is transferred weekly to our account. Giving by this way allows our Finance Committee the flexibility to forecast and plan our day to day expenditure and funds for future projects.

LENT: During Lent we will have Stations of the Cross on a Friday morning after Mass and on a Monday evening at 6.15 pm when there is an evening Mass. On a Tuesday morning we will have Exposition from 9.15am to 9.45am along with confessions. **Please note this Friday Stations of the Cross will be at 6.15pm instead of Friday morning.**

LOURDES: Diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes – Fr Mark is highlighting the Diocesan pilgrimage to Lourdes which starts on 23rd August for seven nights at a cost of £1100 per person which includes direct flights from Stansted, airport transport in Lourdes, seven nights accommodation in a 4 star hotel, full board (breakfast, lunch and dinner each day) and excursions to Bartres and the Lake and fully escorted Pilgrimages. Fr Mark is also hoping to go himself. Please contact the Parish office if you would be interested in going. If there is enough interest we will look into booking a coach for the airports runs to and from Stanstead.
