FIRST HOLY COMMUNION AND CONFIRMATION PREPARATION

We will continue to follow the diocesan approach of preparing children for First Holy Communion and Confirmation within the parish, supported by our catechists and clergy.

Children attending both Catholic and state schools will prepare together through Saturday morning sessions. This was introduced last year and has been a wonderful opportunity for children from across Corby to learn, grow in faith and get to know one another.

PLANS FOR OUR NEW PARISH OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD, CORBY

As we come together as one parish, we are looking at ways to improve the facilities at both Our Lady's and St Brendan's so that they better support our parish community and our mission for the future. At Our Lady's, work is already under way in the presbytery to create a larger parish office. This will allow the administration from our former four parishes to be brought together in one place, providing a suitable workspace for Anne, our parish secretary, the priests, and Liz, Chair of the Finance Committee. We hope this work will be completed by the end of September. At St Brendan's, more substantial improvements are being planned. These include a disabled toilet at the back of the church for general use, helping to reduce movement and distraction during Mass. We also hope to modernise and enlarge the Parish Room, provide an additional accessible toilet, and create access to the garden so that it can be enjoyed during parish events. We will be exploring fundraising opportunities to help make these improvements possible. These changes will benefit the whole parish and help make our administration and facilities more welcoming and effective. Fr Mark will keep everyone updated as the plans progress.

SUMMER SCHEDULE: Fr Mark and Fr Chris will look at the Mass schedule in September, but during July and August we ask you to check the newsletter for weekday Masses. Fr Chris is now back and Fr Mark will be going away in August. We plan to keep the Sunday Mass schedule as normal during the summer.
